

ESNZ MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION GUIDE

1. APPLICANT DETAILS

Fill in the name and address details completely, and clearly. It is especially important for existing members to fill in these details if they have changed address, but not yet advised ESNZ.

The contact details such as phone and email will show up on your membership entry form. We will not give out your personal details, nor email, for advertising purposes.

*Provision of a **birth date** is mandatory for ALL members. If you fail to provide a date of birth, your application will be returned to you.*

If you have been a member of ESNZ before, or have purchased items from ESNZ, you will have been assigned a number in our database. Please provide this number with your application, so that we do not create a duplicate file for you. If think you may have been given a membership number in the past, but are unsure of where to find this, please contact ESNZ and the membership services team will search for your details.

2. BULLETIN MAGAZINE SUBSCRIPTION

The Bulletin contains all the latest ESNZ updates, such as changes in rules and information about the sport, as well as rider profiles and discipline articles. The Bulletin is also your source for event schedules and entry details. The Bulletin is printed 11 out of 12 months per year, and is a helpful publication for all ESNZ members.

3. ESNZ MEMBERSHIP FEES

Ensure you select the correct membership category for the level of competition you wish to compete in:

- * Senior Non-Competitor memberships are for ESNZ officials, or horse owners.
- * Junior Competitor memberships are for riders who are **under 18 years of age**.
- * Senior Competitor and Senior Training Competitor memberships are for riders 18 years and over. Refer to the table below for details of whether you need to become a Senior Training Competitor (Non Graded), or Senior Competitor (Graded).

Dressage	Senior Training Competitor (Non-Graded)	Training Classes
Dressage	Senior Competitor (Graded)	Preliminary Classes and Above
Endurance	Senior Training Competitor (Non-Graded)	Open and below
Endurance	Senior Competitor (Graded)	1* and above
Eventing	Senior Training Competitor (Non-Graded)	Pre Novice and below
Eventing	Senior Competitor (Graded)	Novice and above
Showjumping	Senior Training Competitor (Non-Graded)	Below, and not including, 1m
Showjumping	Senior Competitor (Graded)	1m and above
Show Hunter	Senior Training Competitor (Non-Graded)	Training and Equitation Classes
Show Hunter	Senior Competitor (Graded)	First Year Registered and Open Classes

There are also Life Memberships available, for both Competitors and Non Competitors (officials). There is just one fee, with no annual upkeep, and this will cover your membership for a lifetime. ESNZ will provide competing life members with entry forms upon request as needed.

FOREIGN RIDERS

Foreign riders visiting for a short time have the option of competing on a 3 Month Guest Membership. This is a reduced fee membership, for which a membership card, and official ESNZ entry forms will be issued.

If you are a foreign rider, i.e. you do not hold a NZ passport or citizenship, and you wish to take part in **FEI competition** held in NZ, you must provide a Rider License from the Federation in your birth country. Check with ESNZ if you are uncertain whether this will apply to you.

4. FURTHER DETAILS

If you are an Endurance rider, tick the appropriate box and circle your current grade as indicated. If you are a new CTR or Endurance rider, you are able to have three events backdated and lodged in our database to count toward your grade. You will need to attach details and a copy of the 'Day Vet Card' for each event to the application.

*Endurance or CTR riders wishing to have previous rides recorded with ESNZ will need to include copies of **up to three** 'Day Vet Cards' with their application.*

By indicating which discipline you are interested in receiving information from, you are allowing ESNZ to place you on an appropriate distribution lists. You will be sent information and updates via email or mail. If you do not wish to receive information or updates this way, do not tick any of the boxes, and you will not be added to the discipline distribution lists.

5. DECLARATION

Ensure you read the declaration carefully, and then sign and date the application form. Membership applications for new members, who do not sign the declaration, will not be processed. All applications that are completed incorrectly will be returned to the applicant.

6. CHECKLIST

Where appropriate, I have:

- double checked my contact details;
- selected the correct membership category;
- included Rider License from my National Federation;
- added up my application correctly;
- signed the declaration;
- included full payment: Cheque or Credit Card Details.
