A	Enter in working trot
X	Halt - salute, proceed in working trot
C	Track to the right
CB	Working trot
BX	Half circle 10 m to the right (sitting)
XE	Half circle 10 m to the left (sitting)
VKAF	Collected trot
FXH	Medium trot
H	Working trot
CA	Serpentine 3 loops (touching the long side)
KXM	Medium trot
MC	Collected trot
C	Halt - Immobility 4 seconds
	Proceed in medium walk
HB	Medium walk
BK	Medium walk, let the horse stretch on a long rein
K	Retake the reins
KA	Medium walk
A	Working canter left (may be progressive)
AFB	Working canter
BRSE	Medium canter. Through a half circle (20m) between R & S
E	Collected canter
K	Half circle 12 m, returning to the track at E
E	Counter canter
Before H	Change of lead through trot 3-5 steps
CMB	Collected canter
BE	Half circle collected canter, give and retake the reins for two strides over the centre line *
H	Half circle 12m, returning to the track at E
E	Counter canter
Before K	Change of lead through trot 3-5 steps
F	Working Trot
PV	Half circle 20m, let the horse stretch on a long rein, rising trot
Between V & K	Retake the reins
A	Down the centre line
X	Halt - immobility - salute

\* The head of the horse should remain in a steady position

<b>1. Trot</b> Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity impulsion, swinging back, ground cover, willingness to collect		
<b>2. Walk</b> Rhythm, relaxation, activity, ground cover		
<b>3. Canter</b> Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity, natural balance, impulsion, willingness to collect, ground cover, uphill tendency		
<b>4. Submission</b> Standard of training on basis of "Training Scale" (suppleness, contact, straightness). Obedience, including the different movements. Transitions within the paces.		
<b>5. Perspective</b> Potential as dressage horse, ability to collect and take weight
