Support People

If you are bringing a support person that isn't a rider entered in the show you must enter the number of extra people as a rider support fee (no charge). Please keep the number of support people to a minimum. We reserve the right to limit the number of support people.

Volunteers

We ask that every rider/family supply a volunteer, this may be a rider or supporter. When you are filing your entry enter the name of this person, or your name, and select the role you would like to volunteer for. These will be split into AM/PM each day. We will allocate you times within these slots once we have the timetable done and will try to work around your riding. We will attempt to keep the length of time for each volunteer to a maximum of one class.

Yarding

You must enter the day you are arriving and the number of nights you are staying when you are entering the event. If you want to be in a yarding bubble with someone else both people need to note this at time of entry.

FRIDAY 1ST OCTOBER

The Indoor Arena will have a full course available for training rounds. Each combination participating will get 2 minutes in the arena to use as they please. If we get large entries we will move the lower heights into the sand arena.

Tidy dress is required and must wear a collared shirt.

Entry and Prizemoney Conditions

Entries open:	Sunday 19th September 2021
Entries close:	Monday 27th September 2021 or when the show is at capacity
Payment:	Payment must be made at time of entry via POLi Payments (internet banking) or Stripe (Credit Card). Payments made with Stripe have a 3.2% fee added.
Late Entries:	Entries made after Monday 27th September will incur a 50% late entry fee subject to availability.
Changes:	Class changes can only be accepted via MyEntries on EvoEvents. There will be no office. Class changes must be made before 6pm the day before the class, or 30mins after your last class whichever is the latest.
Scratchings:	Scratchings must be made online at EvoEvents or via email. Scratchings made before the close of entries will be refunded all entry fees, not marked as non-refundable. Scratching made before Friday 1st October will be refunded all entry fees, not marked as non-refundable, less 25%. All yarding, camping and facility fees will be refunded in full. Scratchings made after Thursday 30th September will receive no refund except with a vet or doctors certificate and then you will be refunded all entry fees, not marked as non-refundable, less 50%. All yarding, camping and facility fees will be refunded in full.
Refunds & Prize Money:	All refunds and prize money will be paid electronically following the completion of the show. These will be paid into the bank account nominated on EvoEvents of the account holder that completed the entry. All advertised prize money will be paid and if required additional prize money will be paid on a 1:7 ratio. Your bank account must be verified by the 15th October 2021 to receive prize money. Any queries must be made by the 31st October 2021. No prize money or refunds will be paid out after that date.

General Conditions

- All competitors enter at their own risk.
- By completing an entry all competitors agree to abide by the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and both the shows and the National Equestrian Centres health and safety policies.
- The organizing group reserves the right to alter or cancel any classes at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to change or amend the schedule, including prize money at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to refuse and or cancel an entry with no reason required.
- The organizing group decisions are final.
- If an 'act of god' event occurs (including COVID-19) that requires the event to be canceled the following refund applies. Before 1st October - full refund of all fees except the covid levy, online entry fee, and any credit card fees.
- Formal dress in all rings on Saturday and Sunday.
- **All rings will run strictly in draw order and you must ride in your allocated slot. Unless judges permission is granted Horses/ponies must be ridden in draw order and riders must be at the gate ready to compete. If not a 3 minute warning bell will be rung, which will result in the elimination of the combination if still not available at the conclusion of 3 minutes.**
- All fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- All riders, horses, and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ registration.
- Parents are responsible for children under the age of 18 at all times.
- The ESNZ drug and alcohol policy will be enforced at this show. Underage drinking and the use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are welcome at the show but must be on a leash at all times. This applies to all parts of the property, including the XC course and hacking areas. Dogs are not allowed in any building. Owners are required to pick up any droppings and dispose of them in the skip bins. Failure to comply will result in the dog having to be removed from the grounds.
- Riders must wear a wristband appropriate to their COVID bubble at all times.
- Each rider must supply a volunteer.

Yarding Conditions

There are no horses to be left unattended tied to trucks or floats as per the NEC rules. All yards must be left clean.

There is limited covered horse accommodations available at the National Equestrian Centre. Covered yards will be allocated on the following basis

- NEC Leased yard holders
- Sponsors
- Horses of riders that compete at 1.35m and above (includes all of these riders horses)
- Ponies of riders that compete at 1.15m and above (includes all of these riders horses)
- Horses of riders that compete at 1.25m and above (includes all of these riders horses)
- Any remaining yards will be allocated on a first in first serve basis
- The organizing group reserves the right to allocate outside of these priorities as they see fit

If you wish to have a covered yard you need to order a covered yard upgrade. This is charged at the same rate as an open yard and you will be notified and invoiced for the extra cost when you receive an upgrade. This must be paid by the due date otherwise your yard may be allocated to the next in line.
