

ESNZ Membership Renewal Policy

The following outlines the ESNZ policy for determining the start date for renewed memberships and equine registrations.

ESNZ operates an annual membership and registration system; i.e. that riders and equines do not renew for the season but for a 12 month period, regardless of when and how much they compete during that year.

A. Renewal of Competing or Non-Competing Memberships

1. Renewal (i.e. payment of the following year's membership fee) should take place by the date of the renewal stated in the renewal notice sent to members in advance of this date.

2. Any memberships renewed after the date of renewal are subject to the following policy:

- a. If renewed within six months of the renewal date, then the membership will be backdated to the renewal date.
- b. If renewed after six months has elapsed since the renewal date, then the original membership will be deemed to have lapsed and a new membership shall commence from the current date.

3. Competing or non-competing members are not eligible to take part in ESNZ activity while if their membership is not 'current'.

B. Renewal of equine registrations

1. Renewal (i.e. payment of the following year's equine registration and discipline annual start fees) should take place by the date of the renewal stated in the renewal notice sent to members in advance.

2. Any equine registrations renewed after the date of renewal are subject to the following policy:

- a. If renewed within six months of the renewal date, then the registration and annual discipline start will be backdated to the renewal date.
- b. If renewed after six months has elapsed since the renewal date, then the original registration and discipline annual start will be deemed to have lapsed and a new registration/start shall commence from the current date.

3. Unregistered equines are not eligible to take part in ESNZ competitions.

C. Bulletin Subscriptions

1. Any Bulletin subscription renewed within one month of its renewal date will be backdated to that renewal date.

2. Any Bulletin subscription renewed more than one month from the time of its renewal date will be deemed to have lapsed and a new subscription will start from the current date.
