It has been a tough couple of years for the Show team facing the complications of COVID-19 and having to fully cancel the Show in 2021. But we have used this time to reflect, plan, adapt and prepare for what will be our best Show yet. We thank all the committees and volunteers from across the Show that have worked alongside us over the last two years through the challenges.

As one of the largest A&P Shows in the country, we are proud to create an opportunity to bring rural and urban communities together and celebrate the primary sector during our fantastic three-day Show.

The team is focussed on providing an event where the highlighted activities will absolutely be on animals, the competitions, the prestige associated with winning the top agricultural prizes, and displaying the best of the best livestock to the thousands who attend each day. We know the shearing competitions will be fast and furious and world class equestrians will be present and riding on the Main Arena. Dogs, alpacas, goats, cattle, sheep, poultry and home industries will also be represented in force across the Show.

This year we are very excited to introduce a new layout for the Show; the carnival rides will be out the front in the Karamu Road paddock where they were in 2020 & 2021 and general public parking will be out the back by the train tracks through Gate 1.

In the equestrian section, the Show Jumping arenas will be flipped around with the Premier Show Jumping Arena being at the Beehive end of the Oval. This decision was made to allow public better viewing of the arenas, with the new Food & Family Lawn being set up alongside it.

This also brings our Competitions back into a centralised hub. The equestrian arenas are now closely linked to our sheep, cattle, goat and alpaca arenas. Showing and Breeds classes are moving back to the Oval and will be located at the Horse Office end and Show Hunter will be located on the prestigious Presidents Arena! You will find all details in the schedules.

We welcome you to enter the competitions and we look forward to hosting you at the beautiful Tomoana Showgrounds, Hawke's Bay in October.

Hawke's Bay A&P Show **General Conditions**

The following General Conditions are to be read in conjunction with Section Conditions and with the Rules and Bylaws of the Royal Agricultural Society (RAS) of New Zealand.

1. PRIVACY ACT

The A&P Society holds records of names and addresses of all Members, Trade Exhibitors and Competitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show media reports or promotional purposes at the A&P Society's discretion.

The A&P Society may take photographs and video images of Members, Trade Exhibitors, Competitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any Trade Exhibitor or Competitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media, at the A&P Society's discretion.

2. HEALTH & SAFETY

Competitors must

- -Comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments thereafter.
- Supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds. The Society reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds any animal it considers unruly, dangerous or unmanageable.
- Follow the instructions of Marshals and Officials.
- Ensure that they keep walkways clear, and no dangerous equipment or chemicals are accessible to the public.
- Report accidents to the Horse Office or Show Office. -

In any livestock parade children aged under 12 years leading cattle are to be accompanied by an adult. Any animal 2 years or over must be led by a person aged 16 years and over.

NO SMOKING in the horse stables or yards, animal housing, arenas or pavilions. Any person found smoking within these areas will be fined \$500.

All persons admitted into any premises controlled by the Hawke's Bay A&P Society shall be subject to the orders of the Committee and, in the event of misbehaviour on the part of anyone attending the Show such person may be removed by order of the Society. This applies to any person whose conduct, either personal or as proprietor of a side-show, or exhibit, is a source of annoyance.

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused directly or indirectly to or suffered by an exhibit.

Persons occupying grandstands, buildings and other structures or other seating accommodation on the Showgrounds do so at their own risk.

The full Health & Safety Policy & Management Plan is available at the Show Office and is available on the Show website and with the Chief Steward/Head of Section.

2.1. First Aid

First aid stations are located by the Horse Office and under the Grandstand. Please familiarise yourself with the Showgrounds site map.

2.2. Protective Headgear/Safety Helmets

Wearing a helmet (with a red tag) is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling or riding for any reason a horse within the Showgrounds, except for heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the Showgrounds.

The RAS, Equestrian Sports New Zealand (ESNZ) and NZ Pony Club Association (NZPCA) have a consistent standard in approved safety helmets and use the same red safety tags to identify compliant helmets. Some A&P Shows and measuring stands can tag compliant helmets and any red tag applied by the ESNZ or NZPCA is accepted by the RAS. All helmets that conform must be identified by the current tag system..

3. RIGHTS OF THE HAWKE'S BAY A&P SOCIETY

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society reserves the right to, at any time, for any reason and without notice to:

- Refuse or cancel any entry
- Alter the Show timetable
- Withdraw or change any event or class
- Amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries
- Remove any dangerous or inappropriate exhibit or display

The decision of the Society is final. Competitors will be notified is classes are to be amalgamated.

4. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries for all Equestrian Sections are to be submitted by entering on Evo Events; <u>www.evoevents.co.nz</u>, (except Carriage Driving and Donkeys are to submit the PDF entry form.)
- Entries received after 30 September may not be catalogued.
- All entries close midnight 9 October.
- Late entries are permitted but will be charged a 25% late fee. See 'Late Entries & Changes at the Show' note.
- There is no receipt of entry unless requested.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their details of entries are correct.
- Entry in the Show entitles the Hawke's Bay A&P Society to publish a competitors' name in results and distribute with Competitor Lists.
- The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for doing so.

6. SCRATCHINGS

- Application for refunds must include a vet certificate or medical certificate.
- 100% refund will be paid until close of entry, 9 October.
- 50% refund will be paid from 10 October.
- Competitors are encouraged to do their scratching's via My Entries on Evo Events AND notify the Competitions team, <u>entries@hawkesbayshow.co.nz</u>.

7. ENTRY PASSES

- Competitors will be emailed an online ticket that MUST be scanned on entry to the Showgrounds. Please have this printed or ready on your phone on arrival at the Showgrounds.
- Competitors will be emailed their entry confirmation closer to the Show. This confirmation will include specific details including entry pass, maps, entry gate, parking and camping areas/passes.
- Entry tickets for Helpers (grooms, leaders, handlers etc) will be allocated as follows:
 - Competitors with 1 2 animals will receive 2 entry tickets.
 - Competitors with 3 or more animals will receive 3 entry tickets.
- If more tickets are required, please purchase these when completing the entry process.

8. PARKING

- ALL equestrian vehicles MUST enter via Gate 4 on Karamu Road due to safety concerns with Elwood Road entry points.
- All vehicles/drivers must display the emailed gate entry confirmation to gain entry to the Show. Please ensure you access the allocated gate in your entry confirmation.
- For vehicles to remain in this area after hours, a 'camping' ticket must be displayed which will also be emailed with your Show Pack.
- If you require these to be posted to you, please contact us at <u>entries@hawkesbayshow.co.nz</u> so we can organise this for you.
- No parking around the horse stalls.
- Exit using Gate 4 & Gate 7.

9. ACCOMMODATION

- All competitors that require accommodation on site must book and pay for camping at time of entry.
- Competitors will be allocated a camping ticket that must be displayed to have 24-hour access to this area.
- Vehicles that do not display this camping ticket will be issued a fine of \$20 each day.
- If power has been requested and granted, competitor will be allocated a powered camping site in the Karamu Paddock Camping Area. The power ticket must also be on display. All electrical cords plugged into the Hawkes

Bay Showgrounds power boxes are required to be certified and have a visible tag showing. Cords will be checked and any that do not show certification tags will be removed.

- All Equestrian competitors must camp in Gate 4, Karamu Paddock of Showgrounds.
- There is to be NO camping of any kind in public accessed areas, within competition areas or yarding/stabling areas.
- Showers and toilets are provided.

10. STABLING/YARDING

- Stables and yards cannot be guaranteed as they are limited.
- Stables will be allocated to Stallions first, followed by World Cup horses.
- Stables and yards are NOT allocated on a first in first served basis.
- Should your application for stables and yards be unsuccessful, due to lack of space, a refund will be paid.
- Temporary yards are NOT permitted. This includes taped areas at the truck or float.
- Dangerous horses will not be housed on site.
- Competitors are asked to notify the Horse Office if yard/stable next door is not left clean.
- EQUINES MUST BE WALKED THROUGH ALL INTERNAL SECURITY GATES.
- Stallion boxes must have sign denoting "STALLION" on outside of box.

10.1. Stabling/Yarding Bond *this is an introduced policy in 2021.

- On arrival all yards and stables will be cleaned out to ground level.
- It is the responsibility of the competitor that has been allocated the yard/stable to keep the yard/stable clean and free of rubbish.
- All wet & dirty straw, sawdust etc must be removed from the yard/stable and cleaned out to ground level at the conclusion of the Show.
- Please keep a look out for instructions located around the yard/stable areas.
- Competitors are to take photographic evidence prior to departing and immediately email the Competitions Team (<u>equestrian@hawkesbayshow.co.nz</u>) along with name and yard/stable number or to dispute any allegations, if necessary.
- A Hawke's Bay A&P Society Official will be assessing the state yards and stables are left in by the occupying competitor, after the Show. If the yard/stable is not left in satisfactory condition, photographic evidence including yard/stable number will be taken and the bond will be kept.

11. RAS RULES

- The RAS Judges & Competitors Rulebook (see <u>www.ras.org.nz</u>) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered.
- Each Breed that is affiliated to the RAS, offer their own standard schedule of classes and any additional rules that apply to showing their particular breed.
- Should any person or firm be disqualified or suspended by another Association or affiliated organisation of the Royal Agricultural Society, the suspension or disqualification may also be applied by the affiliate organisations.

12. CATALOGUES

- Catalogues will be available online at hawkesbayshow.co.nz or \$5 each at the Horse Office.
- If you have pre-ordered a Catalogue through the entry process, collect these from the Horse Office.
- The timings in this schedule may change once final entries are received and the catalogue is produced.

13. STARTING TIMES

- Starting times are approximate only but the Show will endeavour to adhere to as closely as possible. When a competitor may have two classes they have entered running simultaneously then they must elect which class they compete in. Our judges and stewards will do their best to work in with everyone to the best of their ability.
- To be read in conjunction with the relevant section conditions and rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.

14. LATE ENTRIES & CHANGES DURING THE SHOW

- Late entries are permitted after entries close, from 10 October 2022 however a 25% late entry fee will be charged.
- Competitors can place additional/change entries during the Show for the following day's events. These entries MUST be made at the Horse Office by 5pm the day prior to the competition to allow for alterations of the judging sheets. A 25% surcharge will apply and must be paid at the time the additional entry is made.
- Substitutions are permitted provided the original equine that is being substituted, takes no further part in this Show. The substitution can only be made into the same class as the original entry and be owned by the same person. Vet certificates are not required. Substitutions MUST be made at the Horse Office by 5pm the day prior to the competition to allow for alterations of the judging sheets.

15. PROTESTS

- All protests must be in writing and may be lodged with the Section Chief Steward/Section Head one hour from

the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50 which shall be returned should the protest to upheld. No protest will be received later than one hour after the ribbons are affixed.

16. TROPHIES & CUPS *this is an introduced policy in 2021.

- All recipients of Hawke's Bay A&P Society trophies, cups and other perpetual prizes are required to take prize upon winning however to remove the prize from the Showgrounds, the recipient must sign for the prize and provide contact details.
- All trophies must be returned clean, engraved and in good condition to the Section Head or the Show Office by 1 August the following year. The prize will then be signed back into the care of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
- Permission of removal of a trophy is at the discretion of the Hawke's Bay A&P Society and the Section Convenor.
 Only a selection of trophies are allowed to be removed from the Showgrounds.

17. PREPARATION FOR DEPARTURE

- Clean out all yards/stables to ground level, as you found them refer to 'Yard/Stabling Bond' note.
- Notify the Horse Office of any damage or repairs and maintenance required.
- Remove all rubbish and personal belongings.
- Check your individual schedules for any specific details related to the section.
- Pay all outstanding fees before departing the Showgrounds.

18. PRIZE MONEY

- Any prize money will be paid into a nominated bank account within 30 days (subject to any queries). Please enter this on Evo Events when entering.
- Bank accounts must be verified before payments will be made.
- Any disputes regarding prize money must be made no later than 30 November.
- The payout scale (excluding Show Hunter and Show Jumping) is as follows:
 - a. In classes with less than four (4) entries, only 1st place will be awarded and paid.
 - b. In classes with four (4) entries, 1st and 2nd place will be awarded and paid.
 - c. In classes with five (5) or more entries, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded and paid.
- For Show Hunter and Show Jumping classes, all advertised prize money will be paid out as per jumping rules Art 248.7 .
- Winners will be contacted by the Competitions Team via email.

19. REFUND POLICY – Covid 19

To provide confidence in competing at this year's Hawke's Bay A&P Show, all competitors will receive a 100% refund on entry fees if the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled prior to the 9 October 2022.

In the unlikely event the Hawke's Bay A&P Show were to be cancelled from the 10 October 2022 due to another Covid 19 outbreak, competitors will receive a refund of their entry fees minus the administration and grounds fee.

20. DOGS

All non-competing dogs are banned from the Hawke's Bay Showgrounds.

21. BIOSECURITY

The Hawke's Bay A&P Society supports all appropriate biosecurity regulations.

22. BEHAVIOUR & CONDUCT - YELLOW CARD SYSTEM

- This Show supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system which will operate in all sections and will be used for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show.
- The full working of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website.

23. CLEAN SPORT TESTING

- The use of tranquillisers, stimulants or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden.
- Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of animals is at the risk of the person that is responsible. Clean Sport testing will be carried out under the RAS (Incorporated) Clean Sport Judicial Committee (CSJC) procedures and rules.

24. WHISKER AND INNER EAR TRIMMING FOR HORSES AND PONIES

- As from 1 January 2022 there is to be no trimming of whiskers, eye or inner ear hair/whiskers of horses/ponies competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events. This is in line with the same animal welfare approach taken by the Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) and New Zealand Pony Clubs Association (NZPCA). - Height certificates and novice status cards must be carried at all times and presented on demand otherwise the competitor will not be allowed to start.
- Competitors in any class where a height certificate is required may not leave the ring to obtain a certificate and will forfeit awards if certificate is not shown. Microchips do not exempt riders from carrying a height certificate.
- Competitors are advised of all measuring days and times which are set prior to entries closing for the Show.
- No measuring will be carried out between the closing of entries and the Show.

26. STALLIONS AND COLTS

- All 'day travelling' stallions and colts must be attended to and supervised at all times by an adult OR placed into a stallion box (to be paid for in entries).
- Stallion boxes must have sign denoting "STALLION" on outside of box.
- All stallions and colts (with the exception of miniature horses and foals) must be shown in a bit and it is compulsory for all stallions and colts to wear (2) official "S" identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle. The rider and handler must also wear (2) official RAS armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. Badges can be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ and armbands from RAS Head Office.
- Handlers and Riders must wear an approved Hi-vis vest when outside the showing ring which can be purchased from RAS Head Office.

27. AGE OF RIDERS, HANDLERS, HORSES & PONIES

- Riders and Handlers age eligibility is determined as at the 1 August and stays in that division/section for the complete Show year/season. Proof of age may be required and should be on hand.
- Novice pony stallions must be led or ridden by a rider 14 years & over.
- Open pony stallions must be ridden by a rider 14 16 years and led handlers must be 14 years & over.
- Stallions over 148cm must be ridden or led by a rider/handler 17 years & over.
- Horses over 148cm must be ridden by a rider 12 years & over (except for stallions).
- Horses/Ponies under three (3) years of age are not permitted in any ridden or driven (harness) class no matter what the rules of any affiliated Breed Society or Kindred Society may prescribe.

25. HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

- The Measuring Rules of the RAS apply to this Show.

- It is compulsory for all Jacks, except foals, to wear an official S Stallion Identification Badge attached to either side of the bridle or halter and the handler to wear S armbands.
- In the case of Miniature Donkey Jacks 85cm & under, they must either be shown in a bit or a halter with stallion chain, then the donkey's original RAS Height Certificate must be carried at all times, for proof of height.

- All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership to compete in ANY Show Hunter classes.
- Horses and ponies may compete in Show Hunter under the ESNZ casual levy system but if riding on a casual registration will not be awarded any HOY qualifying points.
- Run under ESNZ Show Hunter rules & series conditions.
- Riders may enter only one equitation class per day.
- Practise rounds in each ring, \$5 per round from 8.30 –
 9.30am, Thursday 20 & 8 9am Friday 21 October.
- Show Hunter Guidelines for Ponies:
 - Cat A: Ponies 133cm & under 3.05m (10') stride
 - Cat B: Ponies over 133cm and up to and including 143cm; 3.20m (10'6") stride
 - Cat C: Ponies over 143cm and up to and including 148cm; 3.35m (11') stride

Arrival: Gate entry through Gate 4, Karamu Road.

Judging: President's Arena. 9.30am, Thursday 20 & 9am, Friday 21 October.

- Overlap Consideration shall be shown to competitors who are entered in competition that may overlap. Please see the Senior Steward concerned but classes will not be delayed.
- In Arena 1, Competitors must jump in the order as drawn and printed in tile Catalogue. All riders must be suitably attired when entering the ring, and competitors will not be allowed in the ring without jackets.
