- Riders competing on a Casual Jumping levy may only enter introductory classes. Can jump out of their category in Introductory classes.
- Both rider and equine must be fully registered and have a Discipline Start to compete in National Series classes and to gain HOYQ points.
- Prize money only awarded where a score of 66 or over is achieved. No martingale allowed in flat class.
- Ponies must compete in the correct category for ESNZ HP classes and must have a current height certificate to compete. Ponies over 8 years old need a height certificate, but it is not required to be current.

## **SHOW CONDITIONS:**

- Local riders must assist with running the show, please use the "Volunteer" button on the EvoEvents
  website when you enter. ALL LOCAL RIDERS WILL BE ALLOCATED A JOB, THE DETAILS OF THE
  JOB WILL BE EMAILED TO YOU BEFORE THE SHOW.
- 2. Reading the Show Conditions are part of the conditions for entry. This show will be run under ESNZ rules: www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- 3. ESNZ fees apply as per the table below. All competitors must have an ESNZ registration.
- 4. All class and common fees to be paid before close of entries—16/09/2023. No payment, no back number issued. Account for payment: <u>WESTPAC 03 0693 0168083 00</u> Use rider name as reference and please note the suffix number on the account.
- 5. <u>Scratchings:</u> This is if you no longer wish to or are unable to compete in the class and are withdrawing. All scratchings should be completed *online* by 5pm the day prior. In late or unexpected situations, your scratching must still be notified to the gate keeper of your class.
- 6. <u>Class Change</u>: Competitors already entered may alter their entered class up to 5pm the day prior. These must be made online to be accepted, no emails or personal messages. Changed entries must ride first in drawn classes. Class change fee of .50c will apply and 80% of the previous class will be refunded. A horse substitution may be made with the secretary prior to the class commencing. The rider must still start in draw order.
- 7. <u>Late Entry:</u> Entries close Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> September. A late entry is a new competitor or horse not already entered by 16/09/2023. A late entry may or may not be accepted and will be levied at \$20.00 per rider.
- 8. Any refunds will be paid less fixed admin costs (20%) on proof of the horse or rider's inability to compete. A vet or doctor medical certificate must be sighted, or at the discretion of a NSJ organising committee member.
- 9. Maximum classes per day/per combination: Ring 1 (2 Classes) Ring 2 (3 classes). If competing in both show hunter and show jumping, maximum 4 classes per day.
- 10. There may be testing for prohibited substances during the Show.
- 11. Formal turnout is expected for registered riders, encouraged for other classes. Yellow tagged helmets to be used while mounted at all times.
- 12. Back numbers will be issued for each equine and *must be used and returned to the Office please.* A \$10 replacement fee will be invoiced for back numbers not returned.
- 13. The NSJ O/C reserves the right to alter or delete classes, alter prize money or substitute for product in the programme, as they see fit. The organising committee reserves the right to not accept an entry.
- 14. Riders are expected to be familiar with the rules of entry where a qualification is necessary. Failure to do this may result in a later disqualification. For qualification info for National Series Classes, please refer to Annex 11 of the ESNZ Rulebook: <a href="https://www.equestrian.org.nz">www.equestrian.org.nz</a>

- 15. Prize money will be paid by direct credit, please ensure your bank account and other details are up to date on the EvoEvents website: <a href="https://www.evoevents.co.nz">https://www.evoevents.co.nz</a>
- 16. Horses and ponies may start in only one Championship class.
- 17. Riders must nominate which class is to count for points before the show commences if entering both of the SI Pony Championship Series classes (201,202) otherwise only points from the higher height will be counted. Points for these series are gained by the pony and must be the same combination for the series.
- 18. Riders gaining first roud faults of 12 or more in the **South Island Pony Mini Prix Championship Series** class (202) do not gain points.
- 19. Remove all hay/manure from yards, stables and float area! Not doing so could result in a name and shame, please report any damage so we can fix/allocate you a new one.
- 20. Any protest must be lodged with the secretary within half an hour of the finish of the class involved, along with a deposit of \$50 which is refundable if upheld.
- 21. All riders must comply with ESNZ Health and Safety regulations and any health guidelines applicable at the time.
- 22. All competitors are competing at their own risk. The NSJ O/C is committed to running the safest competition possible and may change or alter the programme or a course due to adverse conditions, if they see fit.
- 23. All yarded and stabled equines are to have their name, name and contact number of their person responsible clearly visible on a tag attached to the head collar or rug as per JUMPING RULES 200 7 1
- 24. ALL FALLS DURING COMPETITION AND IN THE WARM UP AREA MUST BE SEEN BY A MEDIC.

\*The TiES Futurity Series is open to any Thoroughbred registered with the New Zealand Thoroughbred Studbook and who haven't been registered with ESNZ prior to August 1st 2022 (ie. in their first or second year of registration).

\*Riders and horses must be ESNZ registered to participate in the TiES Futurity series. Horses competing in the finals must be ridden by the same rider as in the qualifying rounds. Horses are required to register in the Series on EvoEvents. \*Seven qualifiers will be held at 1.0m in both the North and South Islands.

\* The qualifying class for this show is:
