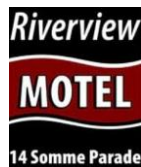

## Entries

All entries are to be through EVO EVENTS (previously equestrian entries) website ([www.evoevents.co.nz](http://www.evoevents.co.nz)), with the use of Polipay – no exceptions. If you are unfamiliar with either of these processes, please do not leave it until the last minute. Problems encountered with the Evo Events website should be directed to Evo Events, using the website chat function or phone 021 684 858 and not to the Wanganui A&P Show committee. Entries will not be accepted or processed until payment has been received.

- **Entries close MONDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2024.**
- **Late entries accepted until MIDNIGHT WEDNESDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2024 (50% SURCHARGE WILL APPLY)**
- **Class changes during the show will incur a \$3 fee & the difference in class entry fee value if any.**
- **Class changes can also be done via EvoEvents directly (this is preferred).**
- **Existing competitors can enter more classes with mounts that are already entered in the show however a 50% late fee will incur also.**

**Ground levy of \$10 per horse** will apply. This will be capped at \$30 for anyone who brings 3 or more horses.

**Rider levy of \$15 per rider** – this includes the rider first aid levy.

## Prize Money

All prize money will be paid out to the bank account number on your Evo events account within three weeks of the show. All prizes and prize money are GST inclusive. All prizemoney will be paid out in full regardless of entrant numbers. Series classes will be paid down to sixth place regardless of faults.

## Yards & Stables

-Yarding cannot be guaranteed for all entries; however, we will do our absolute best.

-All yarding requests will be given to the best of our abilities on a first serve basis.

-Yarding cannot be guaranteed for late entries so please get your entries in on time if you have specific yarding requirements.

-We understand the middle pipe yards are highly sort after however these will be assigned on a few different circumstances such as number of horses/ ponies entered, duration camping at the show and requested.

-These are available Friday, Saturday. If you wish to stay on the grounds outside of these days please book directly with racecourse, you may be asked to move your yarding/stabling and parking (the middle pipe yards will not be available outside of Friday and Saturday evenings).

**-Stables are \$40 for the duration of the show.**

**-Uncovered Yards are \$30 for the duration of the show.**

-Booking is essential.

-No temporary fence accommodation is permitted.

-Yard allocation will be emailed out prior to the show.

-Please leave your yards and boxes clean.

-A \$50 fine will be invoiced to anyone who leaves their stables/ yards dirty and if this is not paid it will affect you entering any future shows associated with the Wanganui A&P and will remain on your Evoevents account.

-We highly recommend taking a picture of your yards and stables when leaving the grounds.

## Refunds and Scratching's

The Association will refund 80% of entry fees on scratching's or withdrawals on or before Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November. Scratching subsequent to this date will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Refunds will be processed after the show - no refunding of \$10 or less. There is no refund of cancelled entries for yards as we will have already booked, transported and paid for them.

## Horse of the Year Qualifying Show

The Wanganui A & P Show is a qualifying show for Horse of the Year 2025.

## Access and Camping

Camping is available on the grounds for **Friday night, Saturday night**. Any other days/nights are to be arranged directly with racecourse and you maybe asked to move your parking & yards.

Please Park in the correct areas; signage will be up from 10am on Friday.

Please select the \$0 camping fee on Evo events when entering and please state which nights you will be staying.

We will be offering unpowered camping sites only.

## **Parking**

The clearways allow for competitor/spectator/emergency and staff access. All designated clearways marked by cones or signs are to be kept free of parked vehicles during the running of the show. All hay and manure must be raked up and dumped in correct places.

**Head Wear** Yellow Tagged helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted. Please note that from August 2023 new standards imposed – a yellow tag is to be worn- <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>

## **Dogs**

Dogs are welcome. **There will be a \$50 fine for any dog caught on the premises that is not on a lead and under control or near the racecourse running rails in the morning while racehorses are working.**

**“new racecourse rule” there are to be no dogs in or around the racecourse stables and yards area. if any committee sees this rule being broken you will be asked to pack up and leave as if we do not follow racecourse rules we will lose the use of the grounds.**

## **Legal Liability**

Our Association’s Public Liability Policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.

## **Protests**

Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each protest. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

## **RAS**

The RAS Equestrian Rulebook ([www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz)) sets out all conditions applying to showing classes offered. All entry fees to all show ring and show jumping classes include a \$1.15 RAS levy.

**RAS Height Certificates/Novice Performance Cards** must be carried at all times and presented on request. No card – no start. No exceptions.

**Yellow Card** - This Show/Event supports the RAS ‘Yellow Card’ system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the ‘Yellow Card’ system is available to view on the RAS website – [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz).

**Clean Sport** - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the responsible person’s risk.

**Forbidden Substance** - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

**Arrears** -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

**Summary of RAS Resolution Process** – the full process can be found on the RAS website [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz). The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases, it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, the it is to be forwarded on to the RAS CEO who will deal with it appropriately.

**Riders-** riders’ age is taken as on the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2024

## **Quad Bikes**

Quad Bikes/and or any motorized Bikes - All riders must wear a helmet at all times. This is inclusive of pillion passengers. No more than one pillion passenger is allowed per bike. Speed is restricted to no more than 10kms per hour. All drivers of ANY bike must hold the appropriate licenses/endorsements to operate the vehicle. No quads in the narrow access ways.



## **ESNZ**

All jumping classes are run under ESNZ rules.

With the exception of Introductory classes all riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership.

Riders must have full ESNZ membership.

All horses/ponies must pay an ESNZ \$7 jumping levy.

Unregistered riders may compete in introductory classes (80cm and under for ponies, and 90cm and under for horses) on an introductory membership or casual membership at \$16.30.

Registered riders may compete on unregistered horses in non-series classes (100cm and under for ponies, and 110cm for horses) with an ESNZ equine casual fee of \$30.15 for the show.

Registered riders on ESNZ registered horses WITHOUT a jumping annual start can compete on a \$25 ESNZ jumping casual fee.

## **Horse/Pony Hunter Derby**

Conditions for the Derby are Judged on the following elements: Jumping, Manners, Conformation & Type, and Way of Going. 1. To be judged in two phases. Phase One – Jumping, Phase Two – Flat section. 2. No restriction on gear except Bit less bridles are not permitted, and Draw reins (running reins, Market Harborough's) are forbidden. Boots may be used, but not permitted in Phase Two. 3. Whips not to exceed 75cm. 4. No gear changes between phases except boots must be removed for Phase Two. 5. The course will include a water jump/liverpool. No time limit, hunting pace. 6. Phase One Jumping will be completed first. Any Pony/Horse eliminated will not be required for Phase Two. Marking PHASE ONE Jumping 100 (All clears 100) Style & Manners while jumping 20 Marking PHASE TWO Manners & Way of Going 15 Conformation, type & freedom of action 15 TOTAL 150 Penalties PHASE ONE Jumping Knock Down 10 First Refusal 15 Second Refusal 20 Third Refusal Elimination. Fall of Horse/Pony or Rider in either phases Elimination. No penalty is incurred if the lower pole in the same vertical plane is lowered. If a horse/pony positively stops or turns its quarters to a fence or has a complete turnabout these constitute refusals. Horses/ponies displaying continued disobedience or horses/ponies leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated. Any horse/pony taking the wrong course or jumping another fence after completing the course will be eliminated. TIE BREAKER in the event of a tie or ties the mark MUST NOT be altered. The TOTAL MARK from PHASE One will take precedence, followed by the Manners Mark, and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie the Judge's decision is FINAL.

## **Show Hunter**

All Show Hunter will be run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2024 and Equitation Series Conditions 2024. Please refer to ESNZ website for Show Hunter Rule changes. Our stewards will be enforcing these. Equines competing in series classes must have full ESNZ Registration and a Current Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start. Equines competing using the ESNZ Jumping Casual Levy cannot compete in any Show Hunter Series Classes. Introductory classes do not carry HOY qualifying points. Classes may be run back-to-back.

**Wanganui Petre Pony Club Show Jumping Ring 3** Open to all riders, NZPCA casual membership form must be completed, signed and returned by all non-pony club members prior to competing. Run under NZPCA rules.

## **Stallions**

All stallions and colts must wear a bit at all times. It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office.

Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring.

### **Presentation area**

This area has been decorated for the purposes of capturing sponsored presentations and anyone else who wishes to take advantage of it with taking pictures of your horses or ponies with ribbons, rugs or any other prizes. We will not have an assigned photographer in this area but you are welcome to take your own pictures or find a photographer on the grounds to use.

**The organising committee reserves the right to alter, amend, combine or delete any classes or start times as they see fit. If numbers are insufficient at close of entries it may be necessary to cancel or combine some classes. Any cancellations will be notified to the competitors Evo Events email address by Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November.**

### **Health and Safety**

We will take responsibility for Health and Safety procedures, however all people on this site need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the events Health and Safety policy. Competitors will be responsible for themselves at all times by observing safe practices/instructions relating to their competition.

By entering the Wanganui, A&P Show (The Event) all competitors are understood to have agreed with the following statements.

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. In the event of any 'act of God' conditions causing a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.

4. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing medical conditions, and confirm that it is medically safe for me to participate in the Event.
5. I acknowledge that there are risks involved in the Event. I fully realize the dangers of participating in the Event, and fully assume the risks associated with my participation and my wellbeing and safety during and after the Event. I understand and acknowledge that the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers) provide no warranties, regarding my wellbeing and safety.
6. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the Event, which may be beyond the immediate control of the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers).
7. I will participate in the Event, in a manner that does not endanger either me or others.
8. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers), the sponsors and other parties associated with the Event, have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the Event.
9. I authorise the use of my name, voice, picture and information on this entry form in any broadcast, telecast, promotion, advertising, and in any other way, without payment to me or any other form of compensation.
10. I agree to comply with the rules, and regulations pertaining to the Event.
11. I agree to follow all reasonable safety instructions provided to me by the Event organisers, (including all officials and event volunteers) before, during and after the Event.
12. I consent to receiving medical treatment in the event of illness or injuries suffered during or immediately after the Event.

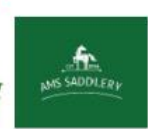
