

Equestrian Sports New Zealand audiences are distinctive

Equestrian Sports New Zealand has a distinctive audience of passionate and engaged people who represent a high percentage of all upmarket socio economic groups. Their behaviour unlocks significant value potential for brands and businesses.

Conservative estimates are that there are 80,000 registered recreation sport horses in New Zealand. It is estimated that the average expenditure per horse per year is \$13,000.

Most horse owners who purchase property do so purely to have their horses at home. For horse owners the average property price (in today's market) of over \$1m is only the start.

Barns and stables are high on the list of improvements with costs running from a simple DIY barn at \$6,000 through to \$200,000. Many build an arena on their property, at an average cost of \$21,000.

Then there is the purchase of feed, saddles and other tack, which average \$7000 per horse, per year. This figure looks extremely reasonable when compared to the most common large expenditure, a vehicle. With so few safe roads and even fewer bridleways in New Zealand, it is almost compulsory for a horse owner to also have a horse float or truck to be able to ride, and certainly to compete. Expenditure on vehicles averages \$38,000 which is considered a conservative figure compared with those who can spend over \$100,000 on a vehicle or a large new, truck which can cost as much as \$750,000.

Those without horses still spend up on their passion; averaging \$3000 per year on lessons, horse hire and equestrian clothing or accessories.

98% of horse owners indicated that a brand's sponsorship of or partnership with the sport would be an influence in their buying decision.






