CONDITIONS:

- All Riders, Horses & Ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Riders must be full members of ESNZ.
- All classes run under current ESNZ rules.
- FUTURE STARS: Combinations must only compete in the Future Stars classes at this show
- All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver on entry.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** whilst every effort is made to timetable accurately, times on Equestrian Entries are indicative only and riders MUST monitor their ring so they do not miss their ride..

COVID-19 related procedures

- All entries and class changes must be online via Equestrian Entries by 7pm the previous evening.
- All riders and support people must register their attendance via Equestrian Entries on entry.
- All riders and support people must install the government QR covid app and will sign into the event using this app. All attendees are required to record when they are on and offsite throughout the weekend.
- There will be no refund of the admin fee in the event of cancellation of the show as a result of a change in COVID-19 Alert Level.

 Under Alert Level 2
- Wristbands will be issued and all attendees will wear the correct wristband for the area they are entered for and are not enter into an area they are not allocated to.
- If a rider requires a driver or support person/people, that person is restricted to the area to which the rider is allocated (pony, hack, or officials), and their name/s must be recorded in Equestrian Entries as a support person. You will camp with that person/people in your allocated area.
- Please maintain a 2m social distance from others not in your household at all times, including in the ablution block and ringside.
- Ribbons and prizemoney must be collected from the presentation area and CANNOT be collected from the office.
- Yards will be allocated with separate areas for pony riders, hack riders, and committee members and riders must use their allocated yard.
- Separate ablution areas will be established.
- If a farrier or vet is needed riders will meet them at their truck or float.
- If the names provided for drivers or support people are not correct, the rider may be excluded from the show.

ESNZ JUMPING LEVY: \$5 per equine for the show (compulsory).

ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY: \$20 per equine for the show.

Required for horses not currently registered with ESNZ for Jumping/ Show Hunter. May not compete in any series class and the
height is restricted to 1.10m max for horses and 1m max for ponies. NOTE the rider must be a full member of ESNZ.

ADMIN FEE: \$20 per horse, non-refundable.

MEDIC FEE: \$5 per rider GROUND FEE: \$10 per horse.

CAMPING: \$20 per truck, \$30 for powered site (limited, allocated on entry) for the duration of the show.

YARDS: \$20 per horse. Yards will be allocated so we can meet our responsibilities around contact tracing. **Ponies & hacks** will be yarded in separate areas if the show runs under Alert Level 2. Limited stallion yards.

LATE ENTRIES: \$20 late fee for horses not entered in the show. Entries on the day not allowed under ESNZ COVID-19 safety recommendations.

SCRATCHING: All fees except the show levy, refunded in full until 5pm Thursday 21st October.

• No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after this time but class changes and late entries for existing riders allowed if completed online at Equestrian Entries.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate or minimise
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Following all ESNZ guidance https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/coronavirus-updates/ on managing events with respect to COVID-19.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy.

COMPETITORS will be responsible for themselves at <u>ALL</u> times by observing safe practices and rules/instructions relating to their competition.

All riders and support people must register their attendance via EE and all people onsite must sign in using the COVID tracer app or manual sign in sheet.

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be **removed from the event**. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider and make an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the **Blue Card process (outlined below)**.

EVERY PERSON involved in BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- Safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported.
- Help new employees, trainees and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

Blue Card process:

ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuses to withdraw from the event, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations
- The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may
 result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
