Promotion Pathway for ESNZ Para Dressage Officials



ESNZ Para Dressage Judge

National Judge

- Minimum list D Dressage Judge
- Minimum age 20
- Attend Para Dressage seminar every second year
- At least one sit-in per grade (I-V), at least one horse per grade.
- Shadow-Judging of at least once at every grade from I,II, III, IV and V, this can also be freestyle.
- Official Judging can also count as SJ, providing it is with a Para Dressage Mentor or FEI Para Dressage Judge.
- At least 90% obtained in an annual open book theory exam.
- Adhere to the Code of Conduct
- Examining Judge to be a Para Dressage Mentor or an appointed Dressage Judge.

ESNZ Para Dressage Classifier

National Classifier

- Be a registered Physiotherapist or Medical Doctor
- Have passed a National Classification Course.
- Be capable of using IPC sport-specific assessment.

ESNZ Para Dressage Steward

National Steward

- Minimum National Steward ESNZ Dressage
- Able to act as Chief Steward at National, Regional and Local Events, independently and managing a stewarding team
- Knowledge of Dressage and Para-Dressage rules, both national and FEI.
- Competently carries out all stewarding duties and understands the relationships with other officials
- Attends a Stewards course every two years.
