Promotion Pathway for ESNZ Show Hunter Officials



ESNZ Show Hunter Judge

Pre-Candidate Judge

- Be a current and financial member of ESNZ aged 18 years & older
- Have basic knowledge of the SH Rules and SH Judge's Manual.
- Co-judge with a National L2 or National L3 Judge to demonstrate ability to judge
- Have name put forward by this Judge to the Judges' Officer.
- Attend an ESNZ SH Judges clinic every 2 years minimum

National Level 1 Judge

- Must attend a Judge's Clinic
- Be assessed by an appointed Senior Judge. This assessment can take place on an individual basis at a show or during a clinic.
- Be issued with a Judge's Card to record judging and learning experiences.
- Good knowledge of SH Rules and has studied Judge's manual
- Basic knowledge of Jumping Rules and General Regulations - shows competency using symbols, scoring, determining placing order, and must be capable of recognising basic course design technicalities.
- Begin to study the fundamentals of judging equitation.
- Attend an ESNZ SH Judges clinic every 2 years minimum

National Level 2 Judge

- Have Judged for a minimum of one season with enough classes containing sufficient entries to show competency.
- Have an in-depth knowledge of SH Rules and SH Judge's Manual, and a good knowledge of Jumping Rules and General Regulations.
- Applicant to be put forward to the Show Hunter Technical Committee by their ESNZ area or National L2 or L3 Show Hunter judge.
- Must submit their Judge's card for assessment.
- Must be assessed by an appointed Senior Judge. This assessment can take place on an individual basis at a show or during a clinic.
- Attend an ESNZ SH Judges clinic every 2 years minimum

National Level 3 Judge

- Have a high level of competency and considerable experience in both hunter jumping and equitation.
- Have an in-depth knowledge of the SH Rules, SH Series conditions, Jumping Rules and General Regs.
- By application with a copy of judges card
- May also be recommended by area group or L3 National Judge
- Appointment by SH Technical Committee, and assessment.
- Attend an ESNZ SH Judges clinic every 2 years minimum

ESNZ Show Hunter Course Designer

National Level 1 Course Designer

- Be a current and financial member of ESNZ aged 18 years & older
- Be recommended to the SH Technical Committee, by your Area Committee, and either a listed SH Course Designer or a National L2 or L3 Judge.
- To have a copy of the 'SH Course Design' booklet

National Level 2 Course Designer

- To have been a National L1 CD for a minimum of 1 year
- To have designed at all levels e.g. Introductory, Open, Series
- To have kept a record of all activities since becoming a National L1 CD
- To have attended an approved course or seminar for Course Designers.
- To be recommended, to the SH Technical Committee, by your Area Committee, and either a National L2 Course Designer or National L3 SH Judge.
