REGISTRATION RIDERS - IMPORTANT



To compete in Introductory Classes – Riders must be either a full ESNZ member, an Introductory member or pay a Casual Membership fee of \$16.30 per day. NB. No casual equine registration or flexi start fee is needed to do Intro classes. Horses 90cm and under & Ponies 80cm and under.

Riders must be full members to compete in all other classes.

REGISTRATION HORSES JUMPING SHOWS ONLY



To compete in Open Classes - Horses not registered with ESNZ must pay a Casual Equine fee of \$5.15, plus a Flexi Start fee of \$25 to compete in Open Classes up to 1.10m for Horses, and 1m for Ponies. If your horse is registered for another discipline but not for SJ/SH the Flexi Start fee applies. You cannot enter a series class or be eligible for HOYQ points in Show Hunter. Classes above this height or series classes require full registration.

All horses must pay a \$7 jumping levy per show.

PAYMENT— IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!

No rider will be able to compete at the show without entries being paid for prior to riding.

Payment can be made via Poli (internet banking) or Stripe (credit card).

If you have any technical issues and payment isn't made you will need to pay directly to our bank account 12-3019-0013702-00 with **the date of the show you are entering as reference and the surname of person entered**. Please email us to let us know you have done this, so we can download your entry. Failure to do so will result in entries not being processed.



SCRATCHING/ REFUNDS

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin) fee.

After close of entries riders must present a doctor or vet certificate to be receive a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees this must be received within 5 days of the event.

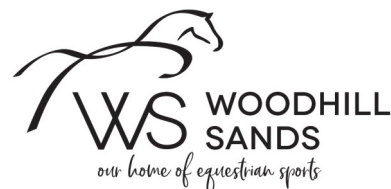

Important Information Dressage

Responsibility: It is the rider's, or person responsible for the rider's obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

- **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without full ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to the date of the event. All classes may be entered using a flexi start.
- **ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the date of the event or pay a casual membership of \$16.30 per day. Horses/Ponies may be registered or non-registered.
- **Grading Points:** No ESNZ grading points will be awarded for Non-Graded classes or to unregistered horses.
- **Rules:** This competition will be run under the current (2023) ESNZ GR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
- **Protests:** Must be lodged within 60 minutes of the official finish time in writing including a fee of \$50.00
- **Dressage Tests:** All tests are from DNZ Test book version 2019 for first event, second will use DNZ tests 2023.
- **Amendments:** Woodhill Sands reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule within the ESNZ and DNZ rules.
- **Prize Money:** The Spring series does not offer prize money .
- **Awards:** Ribbons Awarded 1st to 6th place in all classes.
- **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing tot the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- **Maximum entries** 6 tests per rider per day. Maximum 3 tests per horse per day .
- **Hats:** ESNZ approved and tagged riding hats must be worn at all times, at all levels during the competition.
- **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless permission is obtained prior to the event starting.

ESNZ Concussion Policy

1. This series of events will be run under the ESNZ concussion policy guidelines.
2. Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to a medical officer or stewards following a fall or accident (weather in competition or on grounds –warm up/ float park etc)
3. Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

Office Opening Hours : Office will be open from 30 minutes prior to first class starting until 30 minutes after last class is completed.

Competition Arena Use All Competition Arenas are closed at all times. A competitor/ horse may only use the competition arenas during their performance in the competition.

Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags also that include, person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.

Riders of Unregistered horses must collect saddle cloth or arm band numbers to use while competing from the office and return these after riding.

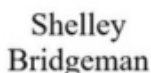

Important Information Dressage

Responsibility: It is the rider's, or person responsible for the rider's obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

- **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without full ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to the date of the event. All classes may be entered using a flexi start.
- **ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the date of the event or pay a casual membership of \$16.30 per day. Horses/Ponies may be registered or non-registered.
- **Grading Points:** No ESNZ grading points will be awarded for Non-Graded classes or to unregistered horses.
- **Rules:** This competition will be run under the current (2023) ESNZ GR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
- **Protests:** Must be lodged within 60 minutes of the official finish time in writing including a fee of \$50.00
- **Dressage Tests:** All tests are from DNZ Test book version 2019 for first event, second will use DNZ tests 2023.
- **Amendments:** Woodhill Sands reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule within the ESNZ and DNZ rules.
- **Prize Money:** The Spring series does not offer prize money .
- **Awards:** Ribbons Awarded 1st to 6th place in all classes.
- **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing tot the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- **Maximum entries** 6 tests per rider per day. Maximum 3 tests per horse per day .
- **Hats:** ESNZ approved and tagged riding hats must be worn at all times, at all levels during the competition.
- **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless permission is obtained prior to the event starting.

ESNZ Concussion Policy

1. This series of events will be run under the ESNZ concussion policy guidelines.
2. Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to a medical officer or stewards following a fall or accident (weather in competition or on grounds –warm up/ float park etc)
3. Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

Office Opening Hours : Office will be open from 30 minutes prior to first class starting until 30 minutes after last class is completed.

Competition Arena Use All Competition Arenas are closed at all times. A competitor/ horse may only use the competition arenas during their performance in the competition.

Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags also that include, person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.

Riders of Unregistered horses must collect saddle cloth or arm band numbers to use while competing from the office and return these after riding.

These will be available from the undercover area next to the scoreboard. (NB: Not held at office) and must be returned to the same table at end of show.
