National Young Horse Show

- National Young Horse Show Application from Northern Hawkes Bay Accepted.
- Series Finals 2025 decided to delay decision at this point pending further discussions on calendar changes.

4.3 Series Survey Summary & next steps

- General discussions on this topic.
- Showed graphs on why riders liked the series.
- Discussed next step could be a deep dive into series with separate committee go back to the public.
- Common point was the gap between YR and JR series.
- Lower level series also of interest, could be run at regional or local level.

4.4 Young Horse Classes / Series - way forward

- NZ on par with what's happening in rest of world.
- Some concern about consistency of judging style classes.
- Course Design component any scope for CDs to have some training in YH CD?

Maybe bring in foreign CD to concentrate on YH CD.

4.5 FEI Topics

- Some shows struggling with costs of running WCs, and some venues not strongly supported (NEC Xmas Classic)
- Focus is on World Champs and Olympics WC rounds are the only way the riders can get the MERs
- Need to discuss the future need to keep FEI classes going in NZ.

4.6 Prime Minister Scholarships

- No applications received yet for this.
- Targeting people in the FEI space.
- Noted need for FEI level 2 judges to upgrade, but no courses available.
