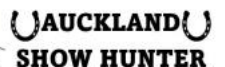

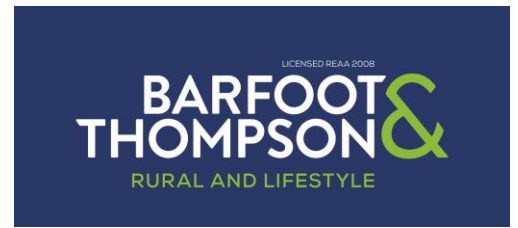

## Membership Requirements – Riders

- All riders must be full ESNZ members

## Registration Requirements – Horses and Ponies

- ESNZ Jumping Levy of \$7 per show is compulsory and is payable by all horses/ponies competing
- HOYQ (Horse of the Year Qualifier classes) – full ESNZ registration and full Jumping Annual Start in order to be allocated HOYQ points.
- Equitation Series and High Points classes – Full ESNZ registration and full Jumping Annual Start required
- For unregistered horses/ponies (or horses/ponies registered with ESNZ but with no annual Jumping start):
  - Horses/Ponies without current ESNZ Equine Registration \$30.15 (includes \$25 Flexi-Start)
  - Horses/Ponies with current ESNZ Equine Registration but no Jumping/Show Hunter Discipline Start - \$25 Flexi-Start.
  - Horses are restricted to 1.10m and under. Ponies are restricted to 1m and under
  - Horses/Ponies are not eligible for HOYQ points (but are eligible for prize money) and cannot start in Equitation Series and High Points classes

## Entry Restrictions & Conditions

- All classes are run under ESNZ rules available on the ESNZ website: [www.nzequestrian.org.nz](http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz) please refer to the SH rules for complete age and eligibility definitions for Pony, Junior, Amateur and Adult classes
- Equitation Classes – riders may not ride more than one mount in an equitation class. Each mount may only compete once in any Equitation Series class.
- Riders may enter either the Pony Equitation or the 12 and Under Equitation, **not both**.
- Ponies must jump in their correct height category for **High Points Series**:
  - Category A – Ponies 133cm and under
  - Category B – Ponies over 133cm and up to and including 143cm
  - Category C – Ponies over 143cm and up to and including 148cm
- Ponies will not be restricted to their respective categories in all other classes.
- Pony Classic – ponies may enter only one Classic Class
- Class changes to be made by email to [tallyhokaza@xtra.co.nz](mailto:tallyhokaza@xtra.co.nz) or online through Evo Events.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to alter, combine or cancel classes.
- All competitors enter at the own risk and must be familiar with the Health and Safety Policy of the Auckland Show Hunter Group.
- All stallion riders and handlers must wear stallion armbands when mounted and handling their stallion.
- No non-competing horses are allowed on the property, every horse that enters the property must be entered into at least one class.
- All helmets must have a Yellow ESNZ/NZPCA safety standard tag.

## Yarding/Camping

- Covered and open yards and camping are available at the grounds for the duration of the show, please book at the time of entry
- Open yards \$15.00 per day/night, covered yards and stallion boxes \$30.00 per day/night
- Allocated yarding details will be emailed to you
- All yarded and stabled equines are to have their name; the name of the person responsible and their phone number clearly visible on the head collar and/or rugs (as per Jumping Rules 200.7.1).
- You must use your allocated yard, please leave it clean (no dung or hay) there are dung and hay piles near the yards. A cleaning fee of \$25 will be charged to clean out any yards left with dung or hay.
- Please report any damage to the show secretary.
- Camping fee is \$20 per truck or float for duration of the show
- If a powered site is required, please contact the Pukekohe A&P Assn on 09 238 8773 or email Sarah at [accounts@pukekoheshowgrounds.co.nz](mailto:accounts@pukekoheshowgrounds.co.nz) . There are special requirements and payment is to be made directly to the A&P Assn.

- Payment to be made through Polipay at time of entry or by direct credit to: 01-0403-0034520-00 **at time of entry**
  - Compulsory - Evo Event Fees – non-refundable as per Evo Events
  - Compulsory - ESNZ Jumping Levy \$7 per horse or pony
  - Compulsory - Admin Fee - non-refundable \$10 per horse or pony
  - Compulsory – Ground and Medic Fee \$40 per horse or pony
  - If applicable – Flexi-Start Fee \$25 per horse or pony
  - If applicable – Flexi-Start Fee (without Equine registration) \$30.15 per horse or pony
  - Late entry fee for entries made after Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December \$20 per horse or pony
  - Late payment fee for payments not cleared by the start of the show \$20 per horse or pony
- If equine is withdrawn prior to the closing date for entries, all fees (except Evo Events online fees and Admin fees) will be refunded.
- If the withdrawal is made in writing after the closing date for entries and more than 48 hours before the commencement of the event, all fees (except Evo Events online fee and Admin fee) will be refunded less 20%.
- There will be no refunds for a withdrawal made within 48 hours of the commencement of the show except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

## Warm Ups

- To be entered online through Evo Events – not available at the gate.
- Only one warm up round per horse or pony
- Prize money will be paid providing a qualifying score of 66% or above is achieved.

- The ASHG Committee accepts no responsibility for damage, loss or injury to competitors, spectators or their property in accordance with articles 114/160 of the ESNZ General Regulations.
- Show will be run in draw order, not black board order. You will be sent class lists before the show. No back/bridle numbers required (but you can use them if you want to) you just need to know your number for the gate steward.
- Dogs – must be on a leash and under control at all times.
- Please do not place dung under fences or around trees – leave under your trucks (will be picked-up by harrows).
- The mobile camping area at the South/West of the grounds is out of bounds. Please respect their privacy and do not use this area as a throughfare.

## HEALTH & SAFETY

The Auckland Show Hunter Group is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, supporters and spectators.

We will take all practicable steps by;

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of *eliminate, isolate or minimise*.
- Insist upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Comply with all H&S legislation, regulations and codes of practice

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, ALL PEOPLE AT THE EVENT need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy.

COMPETITORS will be responsible for themselves at ALL times by observing safe practices and rules/instructions relating to their competition.

Every person involved in an event run by the Auckland Show Hunter Group is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- Safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported
- Help new participants, helpers and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.



# ESNZ CONCUSSION AND RETURN TO RIDING POLICY

- ESNZ's Concussion policy came into effect in July 2018 and was updated in 2024.
- If you are riding in an ESNZ competition and sustain a concussion, suspected concussion, you will have to stop riding immediately and will be issued with an ESNZ Blue Card by an ESNZ Official on duty.
- A Blue Card means that you are **stood down from all riding activities for a minimum of 21 days** and it is strongly recommended that you also get a medical clearance from a GP or specialist.
- The rule, in the General Regulations, Article 150, can be found on *ESNZ website under Rules and Regulations*

## WHAT IS A CONCUSSION?

- Concussion is a brain injury that can occur in any sport. Concussion is caused by the impact of force (a blow) to a part of the body not necessarily the head directly.
- You don't have to be knocked out to be concussed.
- Concussion is trauma-induced alteration in brain function.



Early **recognition** and appropriate **treatment** of concussion may improve **outcomes**
