Young Horse Competitions	Great positive feedback from the first season of the Future Focus Five Year Old League; increased participation, development of young horses, show casing riders/owners/breeders, riders experienced encouragement and help to transition to greater heights/breeders series, organising committees enjoyed support and increased numbers in these 5yr classes. Future Focus served as a pathway to 5 yo series.
FEI competitions - World Cup	It was fantastic to get the final round in at Takapoto and provide a viable series for the riders. Julie's performance at the World Cup final was great for the sport and demonstrates the value of the series for NZ Jumping
Discussion Topics	What is your feedback from the past season that you wish to have discussed
Discussion Topics	
Show Season	Lower participation later in the season - after North Island Champs - attributed to HOY cancellation, highlighting the need to have some elite show, or series of shows, to anchor the 2nd half of the season. If we could have some elite shows in short secession, we may even be able to get the Aussies over.
Developing Ponies	Allowing adults to ride pony's HC. Happy for weight limits to be adhered too. This is to be used as a training tool to produce safer pony's for our kids. This is not to set up a pony in the same weekend for a kid to compete but to help produce young / inexperienced ponies.
Developing Ponies	Allowing adults to ride ponies during the winter months (end of season till beginning- April till July) aim - to produce ponies.
More Lower End Classes	Need more lower end classes. How can OCs be encouraged to add low classes - e.g. 50 - 70cm - to provide for current influx of new entrants coming in.
Behaviour at Events	Rider and supporters behaviour...how to improve this
Ring Etiquette	Ring etiquette - Order of pony riders coming into the ring - too many ponies in ring at the same time. 2 and 3 are in but 1 not yet ridden in - others take over the space and don't allow 1 to have the priority when 1 enters the ring.
