CONDITIONS OF ENTRY :

Responsibility: It is the riders, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule. Riders are also to ensure they are familiar with both Tauranga Show Jumping and Tauranga Racing Club Health and Safety Policies, which will be available at the Office to view. It is also the riders, or person responsible, obligation to ensure all support people are also aware of the conditions of entry to the event.

Commitment: Riders are reminded that while your entry is not confirmed and complete until such time as payment is made, submission of an entry is a commitment. Even if the entry is subsequently scratched, fees are payable, and the scratching policy will be used to determine refunds.

Yarding/Camping: Yarding will be allocated based on the order in which completed and paid for entries are received. Riders are reminded that to ensure a completed entry, all registrations must be current at time of entry and through to the end of the competition, and all fees must be paid. We have not charged camping fees but showers and toilets will be available to those staying on the grounds. Shavings will be available for use in yards and will be located at the end of each yard block.

Payment: Payment is to be made by POLi or Stripe at time of entry. Any funds not received by close of entries may attract late charges to ensure start. Those wishing to pay by manual internet banking will incur additional payment admin fees of \$10.00 per horse. Please email taurangajumping@gmail.com if you have issues with payment. Should we close entries early, all entrants must have payment received by us within 48 hours of close of entries, otherwise will be waitlisted. Entries not paid will NOT be included in the draw and may be removed to waitlist if classes are oversubscribed. *Late entries will incur a surcharge of 50% and will ride first in the class.*



Health and Safety: Tauranga Show Jumping is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. All competitors and visitors to the venue must abide by the Tauranga Show Jumping /ESNZ and Tauranga Racing Club Health & Safety Policies and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office. Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and incident form completed. Any hazards identified must be reported to Event Office. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions. All Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 147. Tauranga Show Jumping accepts no liability in case of injury or damage to animals, riders (competitors), spectators or vehicles.

Abuse of horses, officials, volunteers, employees or other competitors will not be tolerated

Competition Draw: Draw will be available by email and at www.evoevents.co.nz

If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available after 6.30pm each evening on the results board. The OC reserves the right to alter or change the programme to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.

Dogs: Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and under the handlers control. Failure to comply will result in an instant \$50 fine and the dog owner's elimination from the competition

Vehicles and Motorbikes (including e-bikes and scooters) Speed limit for all vehicles is 10kph. Must be kept away from all arenas, warm up arenas, office and scoreboards. Motorbikes may not be used after 8.30pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules. Helmets must be worn on all motorbikes. Appropriate licenses are to be carried when riding motorbikes. Any failure to adhere to rules will result in fines and elimination.

Horse Identification and Accommodation: When not competing it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that also include the person responsible name and a contact number as per Article 200. If the Person responsible leaves the venue, an alternative person responsible must be nominated (and informed), notified to the Event Office, and their contact details attached to the horse's halter. Moving to, or keeping horses in, unallocated yards without authorisation is prohibited and may result in elimination All yards/stables to be left properly mucked out, or a \$50 fine may be imposed. All horses on the Grounds must be competing unless the Organising Committee gives permission otherwise.

Class Changes: All class changes are to be made before 5pm the day before the class starts. Any changes after this time will incur a \$5 class change fee per class.

Protests and complaints: May be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the completion to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. Dress: As per Article 256 - Formal standard of dress. Formal attire in all competitive rings unless directed by the Judge.

Privacy and Media: Tauranga Show Jumping, Jumping NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs for marketing, advertising, and other purposes as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Tauranga Show Jumping.

Sponsors & Volunteers: We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Jumping in NZ, either in writing or in person during the show, make sure to tag your sponsor if thanking them on Social Media. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the Event Office or Event Sec. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably increased.

Prizemoney: Will be paid out in accordance with Article 248 at the conclusion of the show into the bank account number confirmed within Evo Events (please ensure your contact details are up to date and correct). All funds are to be claimed within 3 months via EvoEvents. Any unclaimed prizes are forfeited back to Tauranga Show Jumping.

Event Office Hours The Event Office will be situated in the green building within the centre of the show grounds,, indicative office hours are:

Friday 31st March 2023 4.00pm - 7.00pm
Saturday 1st April 2023 8.30am - 7.00pm
Sunday 2nd April 2023 7.30am - Close of show



Show cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances: Should the event be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances outside of the organising committee's control, all fees, less non refundable fees, will be refunded to the nominated bank account as listed in Evo within 3 months of the event. Any unclaimed refunds after the 3 month period are forfeited back to Tauranga Show Jumping.

Withdrawal / Scratching Standard policy for refunds Scratchings are to be made via Evo Events and may be followed up by an email containing doctor or vet certification or if you require a discretionary refund (as below). Refunds will be paid as follows (by internet banking after the show):

- Notification of withdrawal is received online before close of entries (before 10pm 28th March 2023) - full refund of all class entry fees and yarding fees. No refund of Admin/medical or Evo Fees. No vet/doctors certificate required
- Notification of withdrawal received online after close of entry but before midnight 1st April 2023 - full refund of all yarding fees, 50% refund of class entry fees. No refund of Admin/medical or Evo Event Fees. If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund. If doctors certificate provided all horses for that rider will be refunded. Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee or class fees refund.
- Notification of withdrawal received online after midnight 1st April 2023 - refund at discretion of OC. Applications for refunds will only be at the discretion of the OC and if a refund is approved will be at a maximum of 80% cost less non refundable per horse. Closing date for all discretionary refund applications is 7th April 2023.

Change of Program The Organising Committee reserve the right to change or alter the program and/or timetable to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the rider's, or person responsible, responsibility to check any new timetables posted.
