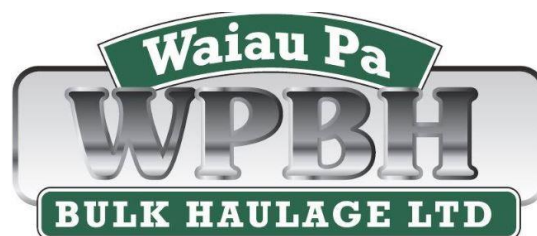

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Organising committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 611

1.1 Article 610 – DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Neither the Organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to Horses, owners, Athletes, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.

2. All classes will be run under all applicable FEI Rules and Regulations or ESNZ Eventing Rules effective 1 August 2023. Version 8.0

3. Excessive entries and balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 645

4. All horses in class 1 are required to have a FEI passport (Purple book). All horses in classes 2-3 are required to have either a FEI passport (purple) or Official ESNZ Identification book (orange) – FEI Article 137

5. **COMPETITORS** - Memberships and Registration conditions

- Classes 1 - 3 riders and horses must be registered with the FEI before their entries can be accepted, See Article 500 2.4
- Classes 1 - 4 = Horses and Riders must have full membership and full equine registration with ESNZ.
- Class 5 = Riders must have Full OR Introductory Membership with ESNZ
- Class 6 = Riders not members of ESNZ can pay a \$15.88 Casual Membership fee.
- Class 5 & 6 = Horses not registered with ESNZ can pay a \$5 Casual Equine Registration fee.

6. All horses in FEI CCI-L classes 1, 2, and 3 must stay on the grounds.

7. **Arrival inspections (ID and temperature checks)**- Horses in FEI CCI-L classes 1, 2, and 3 must be presented for one of the two arrival inspections. Times for this will be available in your acceptance letter.

8. **Horse inspections (Trot up)** Thursday and Sunday -classes 1,2 and 3 only. Times will be in your acceptance letter.

9. **Payments** to be made by Poli or PayPal at time of entry. Bank Account for Internet Banking 010170 0141658 00. Please email a screenshot of payment to the secretary if paying by internet banking. Entries will not be activated without payment.

10. Late payments - Unpaid entries will not be accepted/activated, all entries active or not are subject to pay the compulsory fees once entered. Unpaid/un-activated entries will incur late fee of \$50 if entry is activated by late payment after the close of entries.

11. Scratchings/Refunds/Prize Money. -All scratchings are to be done through Evo Events. Scratching must be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646. REFUNDS: Riders in FEI classes 1, 2 and 3 scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 5th December 2023) will be entitled to a 50% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. FEI EADCMP fee will be refunded if the horse does not present for trot up. Riders in national classes 4, 5 and 6 scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Wednesday 6th December 2023) will be entitled to an 80% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. Queries & requests for refunds including vet and medical certificates need to be emailed to the secretary before 13 December 2023 to qualify for refund. Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event and 1st February 2024. No refunds will be investigated or paid after this date.

All entry fees and prize money listed in this schedule include GST.

Additional prize money paid in accordance with ENZ rules.

11.1 If, in the Organising Committee's reasonable opinion, a change in the COVID-19 restrictions and/or alert level status in Auckland or NZ after close of entries and prior to the start of competition, causes event cancellation or amendment, a minimum of 50% of entry fees will be refunded.

12. Change of class, horses, or riders in classes 1-3 will not be accepted from Friday 1st December 2023. Any decisions other than that of the FEI to change after this date will result in the entry being scratched from the event.

13. Qualifications (MERs)—See the ESNZ Eventing website/resources/riders.

14. Yards All yards are to be left clean and empty, any bedding that has been used is to be removed and placed in allocated muck piles. Riders will be fined \$50 per yard if your allocated yards are left in an unacceptable condition. If you are leaving early and you would like your yard checked before you leave, please contact the stable manager before you depart. Please report any damaged yards to the stable manager throughout the event. BYO Shavings.
