**TiES Jumping Futurity Series Entry Criteria**

- Horse to be in its first two years of ESNZ registration. i.e. for this season cannot have been registered before 1st August 2022.
- May have been competing on a ESNZ casual/flexi-start before this.
- Horses must be fully ESNZ registered with an annual Jumping Discipline start to enter the series.
- Retrainers can compete in the series.
- Any TB with NZTR reg can enter the series if eligible.
- Bonus \$200 for the top placed horse from an acknowledged retrainer.
- ESNZ Jumping will pay prize money into accounts.

### SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter rules.
- Show Hunter rules can be found on the Jumping/ Show Hunter ESNZ website.
- Ring familiarisation is one round to allow horses/ponies familiarise themselves with the ring. This is NOT a time for schooling. This will be strictly adhered to.
- Only horses/ponies/riders wearing and using legal allowed gear will be allowed into the ring to compete. This includes warm-ups, introductory and open classes.
- Horses competing in the Introductory section are not eligible to compete in the OPEN section or Open horses in Introductory classes. Riders may compete in both sections.
- Ponies will not be restricted to their respective categories in Introductory or Open classes but they MUST compete in the correct height category for High Points.
- Riders can only enter either the Waikato/BOP 12 & under Equitation Series or the Big On Writing Pony Equitation Series.
- Ponies can only enter five (5) classes- (both Introductory and Open) - plus ONE equitation class
- Only Horses/ponies with Annual Start registration will gain HOY points in classes designated HOYQ. Prize money and HOYQ points will be awarded to place getters being awarded 66% or greater in Open classes.
- Entries in the Category A High Points series class will compete for a rug over the Ashburton Area and Canterbury Area registered shows 2023/2024 season.



### GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

- All classes run under ESNZ/JNZ/SHNZ rules. Please see the ESNZ website for current Rules and Series/High Points conditions [www.nzequestrian.org.nz](http://www.nzequestrian.org.nz)
- Show Jumping - ONE championship or Grand/Mini Prix start per horse/pony.
- Class 22 - Ponies with 20 penalties or less proceed to second round
- Class 23 – Horse with 20 penalties or less proceed to second round
- South Island Show Jumping Series & Tavern Harewood Gentleman Rider Series– 2023/2024 Season
- Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or amend any class as it deems fit.
- No new competitors or equines will be allowed to enter once the show has started.
- Dress code – Formal riding attire in all show jumping and show hunter rings
- Riders must wear tagged helmets and must always be done up whether competing or training at any time on the grounds. Article 151 will be enforced. As per ESNZ Rules
- The Ashburton Area Show Jumping & Show Hunter reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- By entering or attending the Ashburton Area ESNZ Jumping & Show Hunter Show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day.
- Official Photographers assigned to the event by Ashburton Area Show Jumping & Show Hunter organising committee are the only media to be sold or advertised.
- Concussions: Any rider that falls or has a knock to the head, must be checked by St Johns before remounting. Any rider deemed to be concussed will not be allowed to ride for the rest of the show. The new ESNZ fall card protocols must be followed. Should you fall during our event you will be issued with this card which must be signed by the attending medical officer (St Johns) before continuing and you must carry this card with you for the entirety of the show.
- ALL local Riders must provide help throughout the weekend. Please contact Sally Childs (0276307503) to be allocated a job.
- DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES AND CLEANED UP AFTER

### STABLING & YARD CONDITIONS

- Stables/Covered Yards & Open Yards will be allocated by the following: Stallions, level of competition then distance travelled. Yards/Stables are not allocated until payment is received.

- Manure & Rubbish – It is the Riders responsibility to clean up all hay & manure from their yards/covered yards/stables as well as from around your trucks & floats. Manure skips can be found at the end of each stable block. ALL RUBBISH MUST BE TAKEN HOME
- Yards and Stables will be inspected after the show. If a stable/covered yard/yard is not sufficiently cleaned out, you will be fined \$25 & blacklisted for the next show. Your allocated stable/yard is your responsibility! We suggest taking a photo of the clean yard clearly showing yard number.
- NO PORTABLE YARDS – EXCEPT for portable yards sourced by the Ashburton ESNZ Area Group
- All equines while not being ridden, MUST have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs as per jumping rules 200.7.1.

### SCRATCHINGS & CLASS CHANGES

- Scratchings prior to close of entries or riders that have been issued with an ESNZ Blue card – Full refund (excluding non-refundable admin fee)
- Scratchings after close of entries - 75% refunds given with proof of inability to compete (Doctor or Vet Certificate only accepted). Doctor or Vet Certificate must be received within 1 week after the show. Administration, First Aid Fee & Evo Events Booking Fee non-refundable. No Vet or Doctor Certificate no refund. No Exceptions.
- There will be no refunds given on late entries.
- Scratching from a class and entering another class – 75% refund on scratched class, normal entry fee on new class entered.
- Scratching from class and no other class entered - No refund
- Changes must be made 30 minutes before the start of the class, except for the first class of the day which must be made by 5pm the day prior.
- All class changes/scratching must be made through the following options, 1. Complete & sign a form in the office 2. via email or 3. via Evo Events on the my entries tab
- Late Entries start first in all draw order competitions. (See article 252.2.2)
- Refunds/Prize Money/accounts will be credited to specified Bank Account within 2 weeks.
- Any balances owing at the completion of the show must be paid within 5 days of the show. If any balances are outstanding this will be added to your account and will need to be paid before entering our next show
