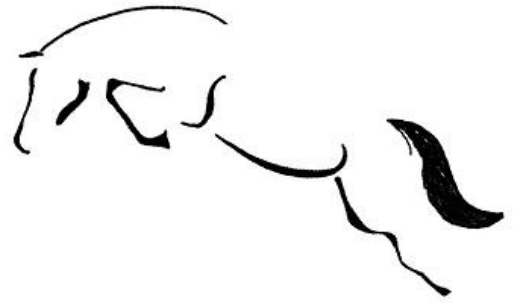

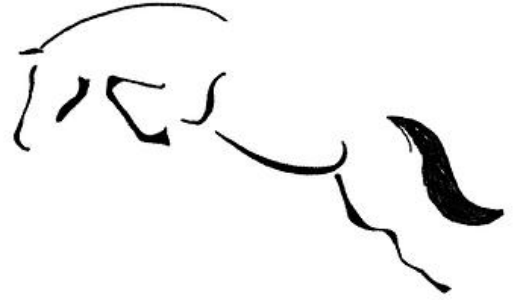

<b>ESNZ JUMPING LEVY:</b>	\$5 per equine for the show (compulsory).	
<b>ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY:</b>	\$20 per equine for the show Required for horses not currently registered with ESNZ for Jumping/ Show Hunter. May not compete in any series class and will not receive HOYQ points. Horses cannot ride in classes 10 & 30. <b>NOTE:</b> the rider <b>must</b> be a full member of ESNZ.	
<b>SHOW LEVY:</b>	\$25 per horse	
<b>GROUND FEE:</b>	\$10 per horse	
<b>CAMPING:</b>	\$20 per truck non-powered for the duration of the show \$30 per truck powered for the show (limited, allocated on entry)	
<b>YARDS:</b>	\$20 per horse for the show All yards allocated on entry. \$40 per stallion for the show Limited stallion yards. <b>Please report any yard damage to the office.</b> <b>Yards and area around trucks and floats must be left clean - NO DUNG OR HAY.</b> <b>\$25 cleaning fee applies if yards left uncleaned.</b>	
<b>LATE ENTRIES:</b>	\$20	Late fee only applicable for horses not already entered in the show. Entries on the day will be accepted at the Show Hunter Office – Cream Block Building adjacent to the rings.
<b>SCRATCHING:</b>	Scratchings to <a href="mailto:sharples@farmside.co.nz">sharples@farmside.co.nz</a> Refunded in full <b>less the show levy and online entry fee</b> up until 5pm Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> January. No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after 24 <sup>th</sup> January but class changes and late entries allowed.	
<b>PRIZEMONEY:</b>	Prizemoney paid to 4 <sup>th</sup> and to 5 <sup>th</sup> in Classic Championships as advertised. Ribbons to 5 <sup>th</sup> . In large classes a minimum ratio of one prize for every 7 starters as per the ESNZ jumping rules will be paid. Prize money is paid in cash and <b>MUST</b> be collected at the Show. It <b>WILL NOT BE POSTED.</b>	
<b>GENERAL</b>	All competitors must familiarise themselves with the <b>health and safety policy</b> in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver on entry. Classes 15 & 35 are part of the Waikato / BOP Mini Series. Eligibility – rider must be 12 years and under at August 1st 2018. (pony may be from any Category). AGRODOME Pony Classic – ponies must jump in their correct height category. The Classic has a call back. <b>Practice rounds on Saturday ONLY</b> Food available on grounds. A&P entries for flat classes and working hunter classes close on Wednesday 9 <sup>th</sup> January. 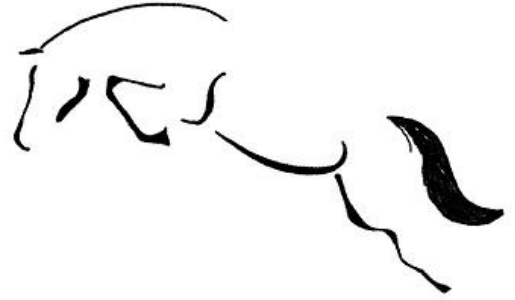

## HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate or minimise
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy.

**COMPETITORS** will be responsible for themselves at ALL times by observing safe practices and rules/instructions relating to their competition. **EVERY PERSON** involved in BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- Safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any injury, pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported.
- Help new employees, trainees and visitors to understand the right safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

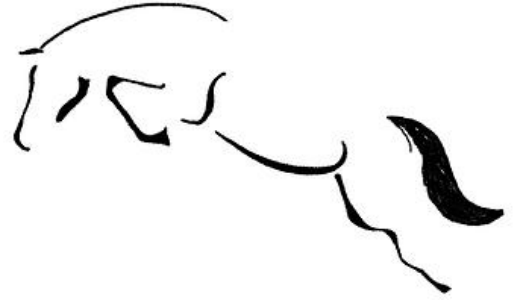

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show complies with the **ESNZ concussion policy**. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be removed from the event. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider and make an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not - if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the Blue Card process (outlined below).

## **Blue Card process:**

ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuses to withdraw from the event, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations
- The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
