CONDITIONS:

- All Riders, Horses & Ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Riders may ride in Introductory classes 9, 10, 11, 34, 35 & 36 with an Introductory or Casual Day Membership, for all other classes riders must be full members of ESNZ. (see attached ESNZ Jumping and Casual Levies schedule for 2023/2024).
- All classes are run under current ESNZ rules.
- FUTURE STARS: Combinations must only compete in Introductory or Future Stars classes at this show.
- PONY HIGH POINTS SERIES: Riders must enter the correct category for the height of their pony.
- CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Only one Championship Class may be entered per combination.
- INTRODUCTORY HACK & FUTURE STARS HACK Accumulators will be run on a points system over the two days, the highest scores in each category will win a rug.
- BOPSH COUPER CUP SERIES: In recognition of many years involvement and tireless work and support by John & Joan Couper to the NZ equestrian community, to be run over both days at the Spring Show 23 & Summer Show 24.
- All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver upon entry on EvoEvents.
- The committee reserves the right to close entries as numbers are restricted, alter the programme or class, ring location if/when applicable and exclude any horse or pony due to lameness or behavioural issues.
- PLEASE NOTE: Classes in Rings 1 & 3 will be run in Draw Order. Classes in Ring 2 will run in blackboard order. Whilst every effort is made to timetable accurately, times on EvoEvents NZ are indicative only and riders MUST monitor their ring, so they do not miss their ride.
- **PRIZE MONEY:** Prizes will be given to 4th in all classes as advertised, ribbons to 5th. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded in the presentation area at the end of each Category classes each day. All prizemoney and ribbons must be collected at the show, they will not be mailed out.
- All entries and class changes must be made online via Evoevents NZ by 5pm the previous evening.
- CANCELLATION: There will be no refund of the admin fee or EvoEvents booking fee in the event of cancellation of the show for any reason or unforeseen circumstances.
- There will be no farrier or vet on site, if required please visit the office and we will assist in trying to locate.

- Payment by Poli or direct credit must be made at time of entry to ensure entries are accepted. Unpaid entries will not go into the draw.

ESNZ JUMPING LEVY: \$7 per equine for the show (compulsory).

ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY: \$30.15 for Horses not registered with ESNZ (this includes \$25 flexi-start). For Horses registered with ESNZ but no Annual Jumping Start - \$25 flexi-start. Not eligible for Series classes. Height restricted to 1.10m and below for horses and 1.00m and below for ponies. Introductory members or riders not registered with ESNZ - \$16.30 per day – Intro classes only. **ADMIN FEE:** \$30 per horse, **non-refundable**.

MEDIC FEE: \$10 per rider.

GROUND FEE: \$10 per horse, per day.

CAMPING: \$20 per truck, \$30 for powered site (limited availability) for the duration of the show and allocated upon entry.

YARDS: \$20 compulsory per horse for the duration of the show (arrive Friday, depart Sunday). All yards allocated upon entry. Horses must not be left tied to trucks and floats. Yard Manager is Briar Sharples 027 717 4062.

ACCESS: Via Gate 8 on Western Road only, Stembridge Road entrance will **NOT** be open. If you do not wish to drive over the bridge please request yards at Gate 8 with your entry and we will try to assist on a first come first allocated basis.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted with full payment up to 9pm on Tuesday 17th October 2023 with a \$5 per class late entry fee; class changes may be made via EvoEvents or at the office after this date for horses and ponies already entered.

SCRATCHINGS: To be made to <u>bopshowhunter@gmail.com</u> – fees refunded in full with the exception of the admin fee and EvoEvents booking fee until 5pm Thursday 19th October 2023.

REFUNDS: No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after 5pm on Thursday 19th October 2023 but class changes and late entries for existing horses allowed if completed online at EvoEvents NZ.

BUILD A BEEF/VEGE BURGER: on Sat night on completion of competition, \$10 per burger, tickets can be purchased via EvoEvents.

BAY OF PLENTY SHOW HUNTER GROUP HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of *eliminate, isolate, or minimise*
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Following all ESNZ guidance <u>https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/coronavirus-updates/</u> on managing events with respect to COVID-19.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. **EVERY PERSON** involved in BOP Show Hunter Spring Show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to the Health & Safety Officer at the Office.
- Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at <u>ALL</u> times and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition.

In case of a fall of an athlete and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete must be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on your event medical check card before you are permitted to take part in the round in progress or in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). The card must remain in your pocket and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before continuing to compete. The horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before the equine is permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224).

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be **removed from the event**. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider, and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the **Blue Card process (outlined below).** ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.

Blue Card process:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuse to withdraw from the event, disciplinary action may be taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
- The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database.
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained.
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may
 result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
