# 2. GENERAL BUSINESS

Saba Sam – correspondence regarding combining this with POY Qualifier
 Board was in agreement with these being kept separate as they are now

- **b.** Saba Sam –Area that "won" this class is not an actual ESNZ area. Check what ESNZ area/s the winning team members are from, and ensure any borrowed rider is from a neighbouring area. Ensure correct ESNZ Area is engraved on the trophy.
- **c.** Prize money for introductory classes
  - Allowed for Jumping (as per 2017 remit), proposed change for Show Hunter rules for 2020
    AGM to standardise. Meanwhile SH can offer product as prizes.
- **d.** Nationals request to run Introductory classes and allow Intro/Casual members to compete.
  - Board moved to allow dispensation for this.

- **e.** Live-streaming subsidies
  - Nationals have asked to be considered for a subsidy for live-streaming
  - Board moves to budget for live-streaming at shows, provided they meet the criteria (e.g. professional live-streaming, 6 x World Cup shows and Nationals and Series finals)

  - Full travel fund budget to be split between number of horses applying for subsidy.
  - Subsidy is applicable to HOY, Nationals, and Series Final but each horse can only apply once.

  - Nationals have applied for and been granted dispensation to not hold the Premier League Jumping Champion class the past 2 years.
  - Communicate with Nationals that the New Zealand Premier Jumping Champion class needs to be held and the trophy awarded, or they will lose the right to hold the class and this may be offered as a standalone championship at another show.
