- Entries must be made online via <https://www.evoevents.co.nz>
- Entries will only be accepted with full payment at time of entry via PoliPay
 - Payments by internet banking will incur an additional fee of \$5
 - Internet banking payments must be cleared by Tuesday 17 January or entries will not be accepted
- Class changes must be made by email to brookbysj@papatoetoeponyclub.co.nz or online through EvoEvents.
- The organisers reserve the right to close classes, alter the programme or prizemoney if required. Any changes will be posted to the Brookby SJ and Papatoetoe PC Facebook pages.
 - Any rider wishing to scratch as a result of any change will be given a full refund less admin and EvoEvents fees
- Entries may be limited in some classes and places will be offered on a first paid basis. Those not accepted into a class will be eligible for a full refund of entry fees for that class
- Formal dress code in Series classes; otherwise at the Organising Committee's discretion

- All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership

LEVIES AND FEES

- \$30 Ground Fee compulsory per equine
- \$10 Admin Fee compulsory per equine (non-refundable)
- \$10 Medic Fee compulsory per rider
- \$20 Late entry fee for entries made after 16 January 8pm
- \$20 Late payment fee for payments not cleared by the end of the show
- \$5 per equine ESNZ fee
- \$3 Class change fee per class change
- \$30 Open yard for duration of the show
- \$60 Covered yard for duration of the show
- \$10 Camping per truck/float for duration of the show

YARDING

OTHER

- **Dogs** are welcome at Papatoetoe Pony Club, but must be on a leash at all times on all parts of the property, including bridle-trails and paddocks. Owners are required to pickup and droppings and dispose of them in the skip bins. Failure to comply will result in the dog having to be removed from the grounds
- **Quad-bikes** or other motorised bikes.
 - All riders and passengers must wear a helmet at all times
 - No more than one passenger is allowed per bike
 - Speed must be restricted to 10km/hr max
 - All drivers of any bike must hold the appropriate license/endorsement to operate the vehicle



HEALTH AND SAFETY
