

FYI on Change of Ownerships/Transfer of Equines between owners.

The previous owner of an Equine should mark the equine 'available for sale' through their account.



This allows the **new owners** to search for the horse they wish to have under their name in their account.




The new owners then search for the horse, who's name will only come up if marked 'available for sale' through the previous owners' account.

If there is more than one person in your account or just yourself, select as many persons as needed whose names should be associated with the horse and click 'Add' to send them down the bottom of the screen to assign roles.

Ignore box to the right unless there are persons in other accounts who wish to be associated with the


Make sure one person is ticked as 'primary owner' and one person is assigned the role of owner and person responsible.



After clicking continue, the next and last page asks you to upload proof of change of ownership. This can be a signed ESNZ change of ownership form, signed sales and purchase agreement, breed registry papers that reflect current ownership. If under any circumstances none of these options can be provided- we can contact the previous owner and ask for confirmation that they have sold the equine and are happy to have it under new ownership.

If you have proof of ownership to upload, then \$30 payment on the next page will send this through to us to confirm and approve. If proof is sufficient, we will approve, and the horse will now be under the new owner's name in their account.
