The camp is to be held at Selwyn Equestrian Centre, Burnham, Christchurch. The camp is designed to offer current and potential ESNZ Coaches and Coaches in the DNZ Coach Database the opportunity to observe lessons which will be discussed in a group situation and attend lectures around the welfare of the horse and other topics including scale of training and coaching techniques.

Qualification Requirements

- Coach must be an ESNZ or NZPCA Coach Educator
- Coaches must have a current First Aid Certificate at time of camp.

Key Attributes and Role Description

- Can constructively voice feedback on video footage, deliver presentations, lead discussions and observation of groups
- Demonstrable experience educating coaches in both the technical aspects of dressage up to Medium level, coaching techniques, equine and athlete mental and physical fitness, horse welfare.
