A	Enter in working trot
X	Halt - salute, proceed in working trot
C	Track to the left
CA	Serpentine 3 loops (touching the long side)
FXH	Medium trot
H	Collected trot
Before C	Medium walk
C	Turn on the haunches through walk, proceed collected trot
S	Circle 10 m sitting trot
E	Turn left sitting trot
B	Turn right sitting trot
P	Circle 10 m sitting trot
KXM	Medium trot
MC	Collected trot
CH	Medium walk
HP	Medium walk, let the horse stretch on a long rein
P	Retake the reins
PF	Medium walk
F	Proceed in working canter right (may be progressive)
FAK	Working canter
KS	Medium canter
Between S & H	Collected canter
HGE	Half circle 10 m, returning to the track at E
VP	Half circle 20 m, counter canter
PR	Counter canter
R	Change of lead through trot or walk
RCH	Collected canter
HK	Medium canter
K	Collected canter
FE	Change rein
SR	Half circle 20 m, counter canter
RP	Counter canter
P	Change of lead through trot or walk
PFA	Collected canter
A	Working trot
VP	Half circle 20 m, trot rising, letting horse gradually stretch on a long rein
Between P & F	Retake the reins
A	Down the centre line
X	Halt - immobility - salute

1. Trot Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity impulsion, swinging back, ground cover, willingness to collect		
2. Walk Rhythm, relaxation, activity, ground cover		
3. Canter Rhythm, suppleness, elasticity natural balance, impulsion, willingness to collect, ground cover, uphill tendency		
4. Submission Standard of training on basis of "Training Scale" (suppleness, contact, straightness). Obedience, including the different movements. Transitions within the paces.		
5. Perspective Potential as dressage horse, ability to collect and take weight
