Late entries after Wednesday 28th September 2022 incur \$20 late fee per horse (non-refundable).

Refund Rule Scratchings – refunds less 20% if notified by 9am Thursday 6th October 2022. Thereafter no refunds for any reason.

Special Conditions

- a) To start all riders must have current ESNZ membership
- b) Unregistered horses in classes 5 to 8 may start on a casual ESNZ Equine Registration of \$5 per horse.
- c) Unregistered horses, or horses with no eventing discipline start, may start in classes 5 or 6 with an Eventing Flexi Start of \$15 per horse.
- d) No unauthorised motorbikes on the grounds.
- e) Food and farrier available on grounds.
- f) No person under the age of 18 may consume alcohol on the Rotorua A&P Association grounds.
- g) Dogs to be on a lead at all times. No dogs allowed on Ngati Whakaue Land. Fine/Elimination if these rules not adhered to.
- h) Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money, and to substitute prize money with goods to the value of, at their discretion – Article 611.
- i) No non competitive horses on the grounds at any time.
- j) **As a condition of entry all local BOP riders must supply a helper prior to or during the event.**
- k) All classes part of ESNZ Eventing National Series Competitions.
- l) Classes 2 and 3 run under FEI Eventing Rules, other classes run under ESNZ Eventing Rules.
- m) Eventing BOP is participating in the “Buddy” system. If you are new to eventing or need some support let us know and we can provide you with some contact details of a “Buddy”.

Timetable	Dressage and Showjumping Saturday, Cross country Sunday. In the event of large numbers of entries, some 95cm cross country may be run on Saturday.
Prizes	can be collected from the secretary’s office 30 minutes after final results are signed off by TD.
Draw	Will be emailed out, and will be available on Evo Events after Wednesday 5 th October.
Camping	Yards \$20 per horse, limited stallion yards \$40 per horse, camping \$20 per vehicle/float. To be paid with entries.
Fees	Compulsory \$10 administration fee per horse Compulsory \$10 Medical and Vet fee per horse Compulsory \$20 ground fee per horse

All Yards are to be left in a clean tidy condition. If your yard is left dirty you will be fined \$50 and your name will be made public

Under NO Circumstances is Dung or Hay to be put over the fence into the River Reserve. This will compromise the future use of the grounds. The council has imposed a \$10,000 fine for this offence.
