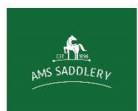

## Jumping Conditions

1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
2. Riders, horses and ponies must have a current ESNZ registration for the duration of the show where required.
3. Formal standard of dress required.
4. Classes 1, 2, 5, 6 & 17 can compete using the Casual Equine Registration of \$30.15 per show. All riders must be fully registered members of ESNZ.
5. Classes 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22 and 23 are run under Series Conditions and are eligible for National Series Points.
6. Classes 7 & 8 will run indoors on Friday night starting at 6.30pm.
7. Classes 27 & 28 is open to all ESNZ registered combinations in Eventing and/or Jumping disciplines. Please refer to Eventing Challenge Conditions on page 4. Riders can wear Show Jumping or Cross-Country attire but will be required to wear an NZPCA approved body protector/vest for both phases of this class.
8. Times are approximate, any major change will be communicated to you via text
9. Maximum of 3 horses per rider per class
10. Equifest reserves the right to cap class numbers as appropriate.
11. There is to be no schooling over any jumps (cross country or show jumps) outside the event perimeter, ie, in cross country course paddock. Riders risk elimination from the competition if found to do so. Provision has been made within the perimeter for schooling/hacking in grass arena warm up.
12. Equifest reserves the right to alter, delete or amend any class as it sees fit.
13. Each rider receives 1 x wristband. Extra wristbands can be purchased via Main Events when you enter \$45(\$30 saving) these are limited to 4 per rider
14. A \$7 ESNZ Jumping Levy is applicable to each horse.
15. A \$25 non-refundable admin and medic fee applies per rider.
16. A \$48 ground fee per horse applies.
17. All advertised prize money will be paid out as per Jumping Rules Art 248.7.
18. Additional prize money will be paid out at a ratio of 1:7
19. Entries close Wednesday 4 October 2023. Please enter online at Main Events.
20. Scratchings – refund for all classes and other fees less 25%. Subject to proof of inability to compete. Subject to conditions and refund form being completed within 7 days of the event. Stable and yard fees will be fully refunded up until 21 October 2022.
21. Class changes will be refund less 25% in entered class and charged entry fee on new class. Class changes must be made before 6pm the day before the class, or 30mins after your last class whichever is the latest.
22. All prize money will be paid via internet banking.
23. Open yards \$45 and covered yards \$100 for the duration of the event.
24. Stables \$120 for the duration of the event. All stallions must be stabled when not being ridden. (stables & covered yards are limited)
25. Camping: Non-powered sites are \$50. These prices are per site, not per person.
26. Equifest takes no responsibility for injury or loss to competitor, horse or gear.
27. DOGS – dogs are allowed but must remain in the camping area and on a lead at all times. No dogs around the yards or in the event zone.
28. All yarded & stabled equines are to have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs as per Jumping Rules 200.7.1.

# Eventing Challenge

Open to all ESNZ Registered riders and horses of jumping and eventing disciplines.

Judged under ESNZ Rules.

The first phase will be run over 6-8 show jumps - **against the clock**. Riders will proceed directly into the next phase. The second phase will be run over 6-8 portable and fixed cross-country fences - **not against the clock**.

If there happens to be equal placings, then the final placings will be determined by the combination who has gone the closest to the optimum time in the first phase (cross country).

Penalties will be as follows:

All riders are required to wear:

- ESNZ approved safety helmet and must be tagged
- NZPCA approved safety vest

Judge's decision is final. They may disqualify any rider at any stage for dangerous riding, inappropriate behaviour, misuse of spurs and whip, ill treatment of the horse or if in their opinion the horse is lame or exhausted.

# Equifest NZPCA Pony Club Teams Event

Incorporating the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show

Clubs or Clubs without branches can enter a team of 3 or 4 riders in each division.

Divisions:

- **Junior**, being 13 to 16 years on 1 January of the calendar year of the show
  - Max height: 80cm 1<sup>st</sup> round, 85cm 2<sup>nd</sup> round
- **Senior**, being 25 years and under on 1 January of the calendar year of the show.
  - Max height: 105cm 1<sup>st</sup> round, 110cm 2<sup>nd</sup> round
- The Competition takes place over two rounds for each level i.e., the Junior team will compete over two rounds in the Junior Competition and the Senior team will compete over two rounds in the Senior Competition.
- Adding the Penalties for Faults at the obstacles gives the Score obtained by each Athlete for each round.
- Only Athletes with a Score of twelve Penalties or less in the first round shall continue to the second round.
- The first round shall not be against the clock. The second round shall be against the clock. There will not be a jump-off.
- Team Scores and Placings shall be decided as follows:
  - The total Penalties of the best three Athletes per Team in the first round are added to the total Penalties of the best three Athletes per Team in the second round to calculate the Team Score. The Placings are determined in the order of decreasing Team Scores i.e., the Team with the lowest score is the winner.
  - Teams with equality of Team Scores will be placed according to the fastest combined time of their best three Athletes in the second round. If the combined times are equal, the placing shall remain equal.
  - If a Team does not have three Athletes that qualify for the second round, they shall be placed in accordance with the total Penalties of the best three Athlete per Team in the first round.
- Riders will ride in Club Pony Club Uniform.
- NZPCA General Regulations apply.
- Each Club will need a named manager who will be responsible for checking rally requirements and gear safety checks.

As this event incorporates the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show the course is has been designed by an Australian Course Designer and will be the same courses used in all countries participating.

NZPCA will select athletes to represent them in a junior and senior team for the Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show. These athletes maybe from different Clubs and will be named before Equifest. The Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show will also award individual prizes for each division.

A full set of Pony Club International Jumping Virtual Show rules will be sent following closing of entry.
