| Number of Attendees | Planning for 2 bubbles (or gatherings) – a main bubble and another bubble for people (riders and strappers) only competing on the Saturday. Officials and volunteers are not included in either gathering total. Maximum of 200 + officials/volunteers so ~230. | | |
| Strappers | May need to be limited but those planning to attend will need to register. Vaccine Pass required. | | |
| Spectators | May need to be limited but those planning to attend will need to register. Vaccine Pass required. | | |
| Officials and Volunteers | Vaccine Pass required. | | |
| Entries and Payment of Fees | All online and in advance of the event. Refunds will be given as required. | | |
| Contact Tracing | QR code displayed at multiple locations and manual sign-in sheet will be provided. | | |
| Secretary's Office | Most activities will be able to occur without any contact e.g. rider packs put aside for remote collection. If any interaction is required that take more than 5 minutes and distancing of at least 2 metres can't be maintained then all individuals will wear a mask at the time. | | |

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| Rider Bibs | Will be provided and returned without direct contact. Will be laundered before and after the event. | | |
| Logbooks and Day Vet Cards | Will be transferred without direct contact. Also see comments under Secretary's Office. | | |
| Parking | All parking will be socially distanced for those in different family / competitor / team groups. | | |
| Camping | All camping will be socially distanced for those in different family / competitor / team groups. Any socialising outside these groups will be outside and maintain distance of at least 2 m or wear a mask. | | |
| Vet Ring | Any officials / volunteers will wear a mask when unable to socially distance from competitors. The person running out the horse does not need to wear a mask in the Vet Ring. PR and one other allowed in the Vet Ring with each horse. A second person with a horse will need to wear a mask or maintain a 2 m distance from officials/volunteers. (Officials / volunteers will be in their own bubble when in the Vet Ring and not in contact with competitors i.e. will not need to wear a mask at all times. Risk is further managed in that this is an outside activity and they will socially distance as much as possible. However, many will be sharing vehicles and/or accommodation so contact in the Vet Ring is not the biggest risk. | | |
| Physical Distancing | To maintain a distance of at least 2 metres as much as possible unless in a family/team bubble. | | |
| Mask Wearing | Surgical or N95 type mask to be worn in instances when masks are required as specified above. | | |
| Hygiene | Hand washing and/or hand sanitiser available at toilets, Vet Ring and Secretary's Office | | |
| Prize Giving | Distance of at least 2 metres to be maintained between OC and recipients (unless they are already in the same family bubble). | | |
| Shared Catering | Prizegiving dinner – people to eat in family / team / officials bubbles and to go up one group at a time if buffet meal. No serving / waiting staff. This event may be held at a local restaurant in which case it would be held under their standard operating procedure. | | |
| People unwell or Covid symptomatic | Not to attend – isolate and report to doctor / first aid person if become unwell while at the event. | | |
| Change of Traffic Light setting after Ride Base opens | Any change in setting would mean a relaxing of restrictions so no contingency required. | | |

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| Enter Overall Risk as assessed from chart below | Low – given that vaccinated people can be infected, there is always a low risk. The only way to lower the risk is to require COVID testing of attendees before the event and that is not in line with Government policy. |

| VERY LOW | Overall risk of transmission and further spread of COVID-19 in relation to the Event is considered <u>very low</u> . |
| LOW | Overall risk of transmission and further spread of COVID-19 in relation to the Event is considered <u>low</u> . Recommend checking whether mitigation measures can be strengthened. |
| MODERATE | Overall risk of transmission and further spread of COVID-19 in relation to the Event is considered <u>moderate</u> . Recommend <u>significant</u> efforts to improve mitigation measures or reduce risk of transmission. |
| HIGH | Overall risk of transmission and further spread of COVID-19 in relation to the Event is considered <u>high</u> . Recommend <u>significant</u> efforts to improve <u>both</u> mitigation measures and reduce risk of transmission. |
| VERY HIGH | Overall risk of transmission and further spread of COVID-19 in relation to the Event is considered <u>very high</u> . |
