



Pony and Young Rider Rising Star Top Ten League 2023 - 2024

The EquiMatch Pony & Young Rider Rising Star Top Ten League is set to encourage and inspire our riders of the future.

This is an opportunity for riders to compete in a national series against riders of similar age, experience and grade of horse or pony at local, regional and national shows.

Entry conditions align with the Gold Silver & Bronze Classifications at each level

Eligibility

- 1. Riders must be Child or Full competitive members of ESNZ
- 2. Participating horses and ponies must be ESNZ registered and have an Annual Dressage Start.
- 3. Bronze or Silver classification is at the date the entry is made on EvoEvents.
- 4. Downgraded horses/ponies are eligible
- 5. **Ponies:** Riders in the pony divisions must be 16yrs or under at 1st August 2023.
- 6. Young Riders: Riders must turn at least twelve years on or after 1st Jan 2023.
- 7. Riders who are not eligible to compete in any pony division because they are 16yrs or older as at 1st August 2023 may compete in the young rider section on a pony.

Conditions

- 1. The competition runs from 1st August 2023 until 30th April 2024
- 2. Riders must nominate on www.evoevents.co.nz by 1st November 2023
- 3. Horses/ponies may be entered for only one National section and may enter any level for which they are eligible under the dressage grading system. eg A pony graded Preliminary may enter Novice but only scores from Novice and above tests will be accrued. If a pony is graded Preliminary but competes in a higher level during the season, the higher-level points will be counted.

Scoring

- 1. Maximum of 10 scores to count from Graded events on the official DNZ Calendar.
- 2. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest average percentage from the top ten scores will be deemed the winner.
- 3. League Points will be allocated as follows:

Prizes & Presentations

Area Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded to the highest scoring pony and horse in each ESNZ area. A rider's Area is determined by the ESNZ Area Boundaries, and not necessarily the Area Group to which they belong

- Section Champions receive presentation Rug, Sash
- Section Reserve Champion receives a sash.
- Top Score Rider North Island 12yrs & under receives a winner's sash
- Top Score Rider South Island 12yrs & under receives a winner's sash
- Newcomer ESNZ graded Dressage rider receives a winner's sash

Gold Silver Bronze Categories 2023-24

- Bronze eligibility % is 64% ALL LEVELS, Silver eligibility is 67% ALL LEVELS.
- Riders may compete in their category when GSB is used, or ride in Gold (Open)
- Eight years eligibility calculated from 1st August annually
- Eligibility at the evening prior to the event
- Graded competition scores only to count Freestyle scores are included.
- Small Tour and above is defined as Prix St Georges to Grand Prix Levels incl FEI Young Rider tests
