Special Event Conditions:

- As numbers are limited to 50, in fairness to other riders, all payments must be received at the time the entry is made or the entry will be removed. **No Payment = No Start.**
- **No Refunds** for scratchings - in order to keep entry fees low and affordable for everybody, we must also keep administration to a minimum, hence the strictly **NO REFUND** Policy. Refunds will be given if the Event is cancelled by Eventing Canterbury due to unforeseen circumstances.
- **Please** ensure that all manure and waste hay from around your floats is placed in the concrete bins provided.
- The EC Committee reserves the right to alter, combine, amend or delete classes in order to run this event to comply with given regulations at the time.

General Conditions & Information:

- Run under ESNZ Training/Practice eventing rules.
- Back Number Holders are required. Back Numbers will be emailed to you prior to the day.
- Ordinary Snaffle Bridle for Dressage. (No Boots/Bandages/Whips)
- Dress for all phases the same as you would for Cross-Country.
- All riders ride at their own risk.
- Regulation Back Protectors for the XC phase (can be worn for other phases as well).

About Twilight Training

We will be running 2 Dressage Arenas at each of the training afternoons in the series with a maximum number of 25 horses in each arena (i.e.: a total of 50 horses per afternoon), so get your entries in quickly. The training consists of:

- Phase 1) Dressage; every competitor completes the same dressage test (as specified each week). Please ride in back number order and in your correct arena.
- Phase 2) Show Jumping; as soon as you have completed your dressage test change any gear necessary to jump and proceed to the show jumping arena. There is no riding order, if the arena is free please go in and complete your round. The course will be adjusted to your entered class height – 65cm, 80cm, or 95cm. Rider times will be grouped into heights.
- Phase 3) Cross Country; immediately after show jumping head to the XC start area. Again, there is no order, if you are ready to go, please present yourself to the starters. It is a shortened cross-country course set at 65cm, 80cm and 95cm - you can pick whichever jump of the 3 you would like to jump. The XC track will be available to walk from the Sunday afternoon onwards and we will also be posting on-line maps of the XC Tracks on Facebook, so keep your eyes open for these.

We do require some help from riders/supporters to run these afternoons - help with the setup and pack down of arenas and SJ rings, Dressage and SJ Writers and Marshals, and help with XC set up and the bringing in of flags and numbers post event. Please put your hands up to help - we cannot run without rider/supporter help and providing help is a condition of entry to our Twilight Trainings
