

FEI Eventing World Championship for Seniors, 14-18 September 2022, Pratoni Del Vivaro (ITA)

QUALIFICATION PERIOD:

Start: 1 January 2021

End: 12 August 2022 (Nominated entries dates) TBC

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS (2022 Eventing Rules, art. 521)

For the Eventing World Championships, Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MERs)* must be achieved as a combination as follows:

NF requirements + 1 MER at CCI 5-L or (1 MER at CCI4*-L + 1 MER at CCI4*-S)*

All MERs must be achieved as a combination and must be clear on the obstacles of the Cross Country Test. The 1st activation of a frangible /deformable device (11 penalties) or having one missed flag (15 penalties) will still allow a MER.

*** Minimum Eligibility Requirements (2022 Eventing Rules, art. 517)**

A Minimum Eligibility Requirement is achieved by completing a Competition within minimum parameters of all round performance as follows:

- a) Dressage Test: not more than 45 penalty points (or 55%).
- b) Cross Country test: –
 - Cross Country Test: A clear round at obstacles (activating a maximum of one frangible device or having a maximum of one missing flag will maintain the MER result on Cross Country)
 - Not more than 75 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross Country Test for, two, three and four star level Competitions and 100 seconds in the case of five star level Competitions.
- c) Jumping test: not more than 16 penalties at obstacles.
