Costs to be incurred by the organising committee

- 1. **Prize Money** minimum of \$1,500. Must be paid to 12th place as per FEI rules.
- 2. **All Officials accommodation,** and fees for 12 Officials as per FEI Rules, and FEI Timing Operator. (Judges x 4, Course Designers x 2, Technical Delegate, Stewards x 5)
- 3. Officials travel to/from event, as listed below. Yellow Highlight to be paid by OC. The remaining officials' flights or mileage to the event is funded by ESNZ, however costs of all other travel during the event is responsibility of the OC.

FEI Vet Delegate (trot up vet) and separate FEI Permitted Treating Vet to be paid by OC.

5. **\$500 + GST to ESNZ** as Contribution to FEI costs funded by ESNZ, which are as follows:

FEI Organising Dues CHF 500 (Approx. \$920 NZD)
FEI Calendar Registration Fee CHF 300 (Approx. \$560 NZD)

Other Requirements:

- 1. The FEI Class Course Designer is to be the Ring 1 Course Designer for the entirety of the show.
- 2. If the show is also running a World Cup Class, the FEI 1* Class Course Designer is to be the Assistant Course Designer for the World Cup Course Designer.
- 3. It is highly recommended that the Organising Committee use all FEI officials for the entire show to maximise the investment in travel and accommodation.
- 4. Officials will be assigned by ESNZ in consultation with the OC, however FEI requirements take priority.
- 5. This is an FEI event and requires a suitable "trot-up" area to be provided for horse inspection.
- 6. At the completion of the event the OC will be required to sign out the horses from the event via the FEI app. Assistance can be provided to show you how to do this.
