Format of the Competition

40 horses / ponies plus 5 reserves will be named across the 5 sections except that Dressage NZ reserves the right not to offer all 5 sections dependent on nominations received.

Nominations Close Date: Tuesday 13th August on EvoEvents (No nomination fee)

Selections & Reserve list: **Selections / reserves notified by Friday 23rd August**

Selected riders must enter unless a Vet or Dr Certificate can be provided

Entries: Close on 1st September on Evo Events with Dressage Central Districts entries
(\$130 per class plus stabling and other applicable ground fees)

WDC Nominated horses will get priority covered yards & stabling

CONDITIONS – see also Class Eligibility

1. **Combinations** should **where possible** have competed in a **graded class** at the Level nominated between 1st October 2023 and 13th August 2024 at Local, Regional or National Events and be able to demonstrate a minimum **total scores/ s as per the Class Eligibility on Page 3**
2. **Rider Age:**
Youth: Riders from beginning of calendar year in which rider turns 12yrs until end of calendar year in which they reach 16yrs
Seniors: From beginning of calendar year in which a rider turns 16 years Ponies may be ridden in all sections
3. Grading points and all eligibility restrictions ***as at date of close of nominations 13/08 /24***
4. Once selections are made, **a combination may apply to move up a level** if they requalify at the new level prior to the event. This application must be made no later than Monday 16th September by emailing dressage@nzequestrian.org.nz **Applications after this date will not be accepted**
5. All riders must be current full ESNZ members at date of nomination
6. All horses and ponies must have a current annual start for Dressage
7. **It is very strongly recommended that an ESNZ National ID Books, FEI recognition card or other passport (eg NZWBA) is available for all horses/ponies at the Horse Inspection owing to incorrect ID and missing information on ESNZ ID / registration forms submitted by riders / current & previous owners that may not be accepted at the event by the Vet Delegate. It is the Person Responsible's responsibility to ensure correct ID papers are produced.**

**** If an ESNZ ID paper only is to be submitted at the horse inspection, it MUST be fully / accurately completed and signed by a vet**

8. FEI Horse & Athlete Registration is encouraged by the FEI but not compulsory. FEI registration is free for riders under 18yrs
9. **** Athlete nationality (if not NZL) on passport must be entered in notes on EvoEvents at time of nomination**
10. All Fees will be payable at time of entry. (Deadline 1st Sept on Dressage Central Districts EvoEvents PL event site for 28/29 Sept) Fees will be payable to Dressage CD
11. Winners rugs & rosettes, rosettes for all competitors. No prize money awarded.
12. All Classes \$130.00 per horse. Includes riders complimentary Thursday Livamol Team Announcement & Draw function. Attendance compulsory.
13. Rider attendance at Judges Review on Friday afternoon after the competition is compulsory
14. Stabling /camping requirements will be coordinated with Dressage Central Districts for competitors competing in both events

CLASSES ELIGIBILITY

- 1 **YOUTH CLASS 12 -16 years** (NZL approx Level 3/4) Minimum age horse / pony 6yrs
FEI Children Team Competition Test **ED 2020 Update 2022** No restriction on grade of horse or pony but combinations should have qualified at Novice level or above as below.
Qualification Score: 63% in level 2 or 3 OR 60% in level 4 or above,
- 2 **SENIOR I CLASS** (NZL approx Level 3/4) Senior Riders only Minimum age horse / pony 5yrs
FEI Children Individual Competition Test **ED 2020 Update 2022**
Horses / ponies may not have 30 or more Advanced Medium (Level 5) or above pts at 13/08/24
Qualification Score: 63% in level 2 or 3 OR 60% in level 4 or 5
- 3 **SENIOR II CLASS** (NZL approx Level 5) **ED 2009 Update 2022** Senior Riders only
FEI Junior Team Competition Test ED 2022. May qualify in Advanced Medium or Advanced
Horses/ponies may not have 30 or more pts in Advanced (Level 6) or above at 13/08/24
Qualification Score 63 %
- 4 **FEI PRIX ST GEORGES: ED 2009 Update 2022** Senior Riders only.
Combinations **must not have** earned 65% or more in Medium Tour (Level 8) in any graded national or international competition in the 2023 or 2024 calendar years
Qualification Score 63 % in PSG or Int I
- 5 **LIVAMOL FEI INTERMEDIATE I: ED 2009 Update 2022** Senior Riders only
Combinations **must not have** earned 65% or more in Medium Tour (Level 8) in any graded national or international competition in the 2023 or 2024 calendar years
Qualification Score 63 %
Combinations who have earned 65% or more in Medium tour or have competed in Big Tour at any time are not eligible
