

NZL World Cup Jumping League Information for Organising Committees

(Updated May 2023)

Budget:

Costs to be incurred by the organising committee

1. **Prize Money** minimum of \$4,000. Must be paid out to 12th place as per FEI rules. World Cup PM cannot be exceeded by PM in any other class at the show.
2. **All Officials accommodation**, and fees for 13 Officials as per FEI Rules, and FEI Timing Operator. (Judges x 4, Course Designers x 3, Technical Delegate, Stewards x 5)
3. **Officials travel to/from event, as listed below. Yellow Highlight to be paid by OC.**
The remaining officials' flights or mileage to the event is funded by ESNZ, however costs of all other travel during the event is responsibility of the OC.

5. **\$600 + GST to ESNZ** as Contribution to FEI costs funded by ESNZ, which are as follows:

Other Requirements:

1. The FEI Class Course Designer is to be the Ring 1 Course Designer for the entirety of the show.
2. If the show is running a FEI 1* Class as well as a World Cup Class, the FEI 1* Class Course Designer is to be the Assistant Course Designer for the World Cup Course Designer.
3. It is highly recommended that the Organising Committee use all FEI officials for the entire show to maximise the investment in travel and accommodation.
4. Officials will be assigned by ESNZ in consultation with the OC, however FEI requirements take priority.
5. World Cup Prize Money cannot be exceeded by Prize Money in any other class at the show.

6. This is an FEI event and requires a suitable “trot-up” area to be provided for horse inspection.
 7. At the completion of the event the OC will be required to sign out the horses from the event via the FEI app. Assistance can be provided to show you how to do this.

 - Equine & human anti-doping program (EADCMP) per horse *\$50 NZD*
