




















CONDITIONS:

- All Riders, Horses & Ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Riders must be full members of ESNZ. (see attached ESNZ Jumping and Casual Levies schedule for 2023/2024).
- All classes are run under current ESNZ rules, these include a list of equipment allowed and can be downloaded at www.nzequestrian.org.nz.
- PONY HIGH POINTS SERIES: Riders must enter the correct category for the height of their pony.
- CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Ponies must jump in the correct category for their height.
- BACK NUMBERS: Will be issued and used at the gate but do not need to be worn.
- EQUITATION CLASSES: Riders are only permitted to ride one horse or pony in one Equitation class per day. Children 12 years and under may only enter the BOPSH & WSHG SH Groups 12 years and under equitation OR the Big on Writing Equitation Series classes, not both.
- BOPSH COUPER CUP SERIES: In recognition of many years' involvement and tireless work and support by John & Joan Couper to the NZ equestrian community, to be run over both days at the Spring Show 23 & Summer Show 24.
- All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver upon entry on EvoEvents.
- The committee reserves the right to close entries as numbers are restricted, alter the programme or class, ring location if/when applicable and exclude any horse or pony due to lameness or behavioral issues.
- All rings will run in Draw Order. Whilst every effort is made to timetable accurately, times on EvoEvents NZ are indicative only and riders MUST monitor their ring, so they do not miss their ride.
- PRIZE MONEY: PRIZES WILL BE GIVEN TO 4TH IN NON-CHAMPIONSHIP AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES AS ADVERTISED, RIBBONS TO 5™. RIBBONS AND PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED IN THE PRESENTATION AREA AT THE END OF EACH CATEGORY CLASSES EACH DAY. ALL PRIZEMONEY AND RIBBONS MUST BE COLLECTED AT THE SHOW, THEY WILL NOT BE MAILED OUT.
- All entries and class changes must be made online via Evo events NZ by 5pm the previous evening.
- **CANCELLATION:** There will be **no refund of the admin fee** or **EvoEvents booking fee** in the event of cancellation of the show for any reason or unforeseen circumstances.
- There will be no farrier or vet on site, if required please visit the office and we will assist in trying to locate.

ENQUIRIES BY EMAIL TO: bopshowhunter@gmail.com – this will be checked daily, and a reply sent as soon as possible.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Tuesday 9th January 2024 at 9pm. Entries and payments after this are considered late and late fees will apply.

- Payment by Poli or direct credit must be made at time of entry to ensure entries are accepted. Unpaid entries will not go into the draw.
- Direct credit payments: BOPSH, account number 01 0414 0041777 00, please add rider name as reference.

ESNZ JUMPING LEVY: \$7 per equine for the show (compulsory).

ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY: \$30.15 for Horses not registered with ESNZ (this includes \$25 flexi-start). For Horses registered with ESNZ but no Annual Jumping Start - \$25 flexi-start. Not eligible for Series classes. Height restricted to 1.10m and below for horses and 1.00m and below for ponies.

ADMIN FEE: \$30 per horse, non-refundable.

MEDIC FEE: \$10 per rider.

GROUND FEE: \$10 per horse, per day.

CAMPING: \$20 per truck, \$30 for powered site (limited availability) for the duration of the show and allocated upon entry.

YARDS: \$20 compulsory per horse for the duration of the show (arrive Friday/Saturday, depart Sunday). All yards will be allocated upon entry. Horses must not be left tied to trucks and floats. Please report any damage to our Yard Manager, Briar Sharples 027 717 4062. Yards and areas around trucks and floats must be left clean. All hay and manure must be put in the designated dung heaps, absolutely no throwing this over any fences, BOPSH risks a fine of \$10,000 from Environment Bay of Plenty if this occurred which would not allow us to continue.

ACCESS: Via Gate 8 on Western Road only, Stembridge Road entrance will **NOT** be open. If you do not wish to drive over the bridge, please request yards at Gate 8 with your entry and we will try to assist on a first come first allocated basis.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted with full payment up to 9pm on Thursday 11th January 2024 with a 50% per class late entry fee; class changes may be made via EvoEvents or at the office after this date for horses and ponies already entered.

SCRATCHINGS: To be made to bopshowhunter@gmail.com – fees refunded in full with the exception of the admin fee and EvoEvents booking fee until 5pm Thursday 19th October 2023.

REFUNDS: No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after 5pm on Thursday 11th January 2024 but class changes and late entries for existing horses allowed if completed online at EvoEvents NZ.



BAY OF PLENTY SHOW HUNTER GROUP HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The BOP Show Summer Show is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of *eliminate*, *isolate*, *or minimize*.
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Following all ESNZ guidance https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/coronavirus-updates/ on managing events with respect to COVID-19.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. **EVERY PERSON** involved in BOP Show Hunter Summer Show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- · Following correct procedures.
- Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to the Health & Safety Officer at the Office.
- Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.
- Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at <u>ALL</u> times and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition.

In case of a fall of an athlete and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete must be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on your event medical check card before you are permitted to take part in the round in progress or in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). The card must remain in your pocket and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before continuing to compete. The horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before the equine is permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224).

The BOP Show Hunter Summer Show complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be **removed from the event**. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider, and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the **Blue Card process (outlined below)**. ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.

Blue Card process:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuse to withdraw from the event, disciplinary action may be taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
- The Blue Card notice is logged onto a rider's profile on ESNZ's database.
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained.
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may
 result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general
 regulations.

ESNZ Casual Equine & Jumping/SH Discipline Flexi-start (Equine only)

- Can compete up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in any Jumping or Show Hunter series classes and will not be eligible for HOYQ in SH.
- · The rider must be a full member with ESNZ.
- □ \$30.15 ESNZ Casual Equine & Jumping/SH Discipline (which includes Flexi-Start for Equine) per show

Where an equine is not registered with ESNZ, the fee will be \$30.15 (includes Flexi-Start)

□ \$25 Jumping/SH Discipline Flexi-start (Equine only) <u>per show</u>

Where an equine has an Equine registration but no annual Jumping start. This fee is \$25.

\$16.30 Casual Day Membership (Rider only) per day

 Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under on ponies and 90cm and under on horses) on an introductory or casual membership. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ.
