CONDITIONS:

- All Riders, Horses & Ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Riders must be full members of ESNZ.
- All classes run under current ESNZ rules.
- **FUTURE STARS:** Combinations must only compete in the Future Stars classes at this show.
- **PONY HIGH POINTS SERIES:** Riders must enter the correct category for the height of their pony.
- **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:** Only one Championship Class may be entered per combination.
- All competitors must familiarise themselves with the health and safety policy in this schedule and sign the H & S event waiver on entry.
- The committee reserves the right to close entries as numbers are restricted.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** ALL classes will be run in Draw Order. Whilst every effort is made to timetable accurately, times on EvoEvents NZ are indicative only and riders MUST monitor their ring, so they do not miss their ride.
- **PRIZE MONEY:** All prizemoney will be paid out in a 1:4 ratio. All prizemoney and ribbons must be collected at the show, they will not be mailed out.

COVID-19 related procedures

- All entries and class changes must be online via Evoevents NZ by 7pm the previous evening.
- There will be **no refund of the admin fee** in the event of cancellation of the show because of a change in COVID-19 Alert Level or any unforeseen circumstances.
- Ribbons and prize money will be awarded in the presentation area at the end of each Category classes each day.
- Yards are compulsory and will be allocated; Yard Manager is Briar Sharples 027 717 4062.
- If a farrier or vet is needed riders will meet them at their yard.

ESNZ JUMPING LEVY: \$5 per equine for the show (compulsory).

ESNZ CASUAL JUMPING LEVY: \$20 for Horses not registered with ESNZ (this includes \$15 flexi-start). For Horses registered with ESNZ but no Annual Jumping Start - \$15 flexi-start. Not eligible for Series classes. Height restricted to 1.10m and below for horses and 1.00m and below for ponies.

ADMIN FEE: \$25 per horse, **non-refundable**.

MEDIC FEE: \$10 per rider.

GROUND FEE: \$10 per horse.

CAMPING: \$20 per truck, \$30 for powered site (limited availability) for the duration of the show and allocated on entry.

YARDS: \$10 per day, per horse. Yard Manager is Briar Sharples 027 717 4062.

LATE ENTRIES: \$20 late fee for horses not entered in the show.

SCRATCHING: All fees except the admin fee, refunded in full until 5pm Thursday 20th October 2022.

- No refunds for scratching or unused yards without a vet or medical certificate after this time but class changes and late entries for existing riders allowed if completed online at EvoEvents NZ.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of *eliminate, isolate, or minimise*
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Following all ESNZ guidance <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/coronavirus-updates/> on managing events with respect to COVID-19.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice.

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. **EVERY PERSON** involved in BOP Show Hunter Spring Show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

- Being involved in the event health and safety system.
- Following correct procedures.
- Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
- **Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to the Health & Safety Officer** at the Office.
- Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.
- **Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.**
- Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at **ALL times** and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition.

In case of a fall of an athlete and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete must be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on your event medical check card before you are permitted to take part in the round in progress or in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). The card must remain in your pocket and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before continuing to compete. The horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before the equine is permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224).

The BOP Show Hunter Spring Championship Show complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be **removed from the event**. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider, and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the **Blue Card process (outlined below)**. ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.

Blue Card process:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuse to withdraw from the event, disciplinary action may be taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
- The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database.
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained.
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
