



Dressage Masters Top 10 League 2024-2025

This competition is designed to promote dressage competition and participation for Masters Riders. The series provides an opportunity for riders to compete against peers at five different levels at all levels of events and competition regardless of whether riders compete locally, at Premier League events or nationally. The competition will be open to riders 50 years and over (see condition 5) and is run in five national divisions plus special awards. Entry conditions align with the Gold Silver & Bronze Classifications at each level.

Eligibility

- 1. **ESNZ Rider Membership Requirements for Series:** Entries will not be accepted without registration as follows
 - Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory, Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Full Competitive membership.

2. **ESNZ Horse Registration Requirements for Series**

- All participating horses must be registered and have an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) for graded competitions.
- 3. Downgraded horses are eligible.
- 4. Bronze, Silver or Gold classification is at the date the entry is made on EvoEvents.
- 5. For Riders 50yrs & over (age from the beginning of the calendar year that the rider turns 50)

Conditions

- 1. Enter online at <u>www.evoevents.co.nz</u> no later than 1st December 2024
- 2. Horses may be entered in any level for which they are eligible as per the grading rules, but if a horse for instance is entered in Section 3, no points from any classes below Elementary will be accrued.
- 3. Competition runs from 1 August 2024 until 30th April 2025
- 4. Maximum of 10 scores to count from graded events on the official DNZ Calendar.
- 5. Riders may contest the league on more than one horse
- 6. Riders may only contest one National section per horse
- 7. Downgraded horses are eligible.
- 8. Participants must be annual competitive members of the ESNZ
- 9. Combo award eligibility: Rider date of birth must be recorded on the ESNZ database

Newcomer (First year member)	Open to new ESNZ graded Dressage rider with no grading points in Dressage prior to 1 st April 2024
Owner /Horse Combo Award Partnership Award	Highest age horse/rider combined. Horse may not have earned grading points with any other rider at any time.

Scoring

- 1. Awards points can be earned in graded competitions only
- 2. Points are accrued as a combination
- 3. Maximum of 10 scores to count from Graded events on the official DNZ Calendar
- 4. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest average percentage from the top ten scores will be deemed the winner.
- 5. Points are awarded as follows
