General Event Conditions & Information

- The event will be run under ESNZ eventing rules – effective 1 August 2020 and is part of the Eventing National Series Competition. The OC reserve the right to restrict entries if necessary, alter classes & prize money as required – article 611.
 - Combinations with 2 MERS from 2 levels above (2* for the 95 open and 3* for the 105 open) will need to ride HC if they enter in these classes.
Note: a MER = Over 55% in dressage, clear jumping & not more than 30 time penalties in X country, & not more than 16 jump faults in SJ – Reference to rule 613 – 11b at www.nzequestrian.org.nz for further clarification.
 - Dogs:** must be on a lead at all times (this is a WCEG rule), dogs must be kept away from the office & scoreboard area for safety reasons, failure to abide by this rule may result in rider elimination and/or the owner being asked to remove the dog from the grounds.
 - Internet Banking** use: 03 0314 0183823 01, note “riders name” & “HT” as reference.
 - Prize giving** - Prize money awarded on a ratio of 1:5 dressage starters – overall rosettes to 6th place, prizegiving details will be announced Sunday am.
 - Refunds/Scratchings** – 80% of entry fee, all yarding up to 8.30am Thursday 10th September 2020. After this date if scratching the Admin & Online fees must still be paid, entry fees will be at the discretion of the OC.
 - Refreshments** – available on grounds.
 - Timetable** – Dressage Saturday, SJ Saturday (blackboard & some classes may be transferred to Sunday if necessary), XC on Sunday (back no. order)
 - Back number holders** are required (available at most local horse shops)
 - Entry status**, the draw/yarding & the ‘live’ results are available to view on www.equestrianentries.co.nz Draw & yarding will be emailed to you
 - Preliminary Results** - Dressage & XC results will be texted or emailed to you immediately after they are scored (revised values will not be re-sent)
 - Yards** – Any broken or damaged yards or dirty yards will be charged to the rider accordingly. Yarding will be allocated.
 - Late Entries/Payments** - You may be wait listed until a scratching occurs. Unpaid fees owed to other WEC events must be settled before your entry will be accepted and put into the draw. Late fee of \$30.00 will apply and/or if your payment is not received in full by the 12th of September 2020.
 - Showers** – Are available behind the administration building which is in the riding school carpark up on Pukete Road (no key needed)
 - The Rider Shop/Rangiora Equestrian Supplies Cross Country Style Prize** – special award – “to be judged at 1.05m and below”.
 - Body Protectors** – New body protector standards effective 1 August 2020 - All riders must wear an approved body protector on XC which meets the following standard; BETA Level 3 2009, BETA Level 3 2018 or ASTM F1937.
