



Hygain ESNZ Endurance South Island Championships 2020

Ride Base

- Ride base is just outside the township of Renwick, in Marlborough, it is a farm paddock.
- Toilets and water provided but bring own yarding, camping gear, etc.
- All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on ride base.
- Further instructions will be posted nearer the time to advise best entrance to use.
- No arriving after dark please, respect those living in the homes on the property and nearby.

Entries

Nominated

- Nominated Entries close on 3 January 2020. Click [here](#) for Nominated entry form
- A nomination must be sent in for all horses and riders that may be competing at the event.
- It is only necessary to nominate for the highest level class you and your horse are likely to compete in.

Definite

- Definite entries close at 5pm 22 January and all fees must be paid by this date.
- Entries will not be taken at the event – this includes all Novice CTR and Intro Endurance (full refunds will be given in the event that you cannot attend after paying your entry fee).

Health and Safety

- For the purpose of our event, the venue opens at 9am on Friday 31 January 2020.
- From this time onwards, while at the event, any person (rider, strapper or anyone else likely to be exercising a horse) must first come to the secretary's office and sign the waiver form.
- It will also be necessary for the rider to collect their rider back number before their horse can be ridden at the venue.
- At any time the person riding the horse must wear the rider back number allocated to the horse. If this is outside of your competition then turn your rider bib inside out.
- Please keep well clear of the start/finish area and the track leading to the start/finish while exercising horses.
- Safety helmets and appropriate footwear must be worn at all times while riding.
- ESNZ GR Article 150.6 It is the responsibility of every individual at an equestrian event to ensure the health and safety of themselves and others.
- ESNZ GR Article 151.7 - The use of cameras by riders while riding at a showground/competition venue (however such a camera is affixed, whether to the rider, protective headgear, head covering, or carriage) is prohibited, unless otherwise specifically agreed to by the ESNZ Technical Delegate officiating at the Event (in consultation with the President of the GJ, where appropriate). Such a decision will be completely at the discretion of the Technical Delegate/GJ President, and not subject

to challenge. In the event that approval is given by the Technical Delegate/GJ President, an athlete's decision to wear a camera while competing will always be voluntary and at the athlete's own risk.

- As the fire risk will be very high at this time we advise you to please limit smoking to your own vehicles please, and be prepared for a total fire/smoking ban in extreme high risk. No open fires.

Manure

- All manure is to be scattered or taken home with you.

Training Area

- A separate training track will be provided.

Stallions

- Please advise if you are bringing a stallion.

Ice

- No Ice will be available at the ride base but it can be purchased at Supermarkets and Service Stations at Renwick.

Water

- There is plenty of water available at the ride base for both horses and humans.

Farrier

- Any request for farrier work will be at the rider's own expense. Earl Paewai will be on base from Friday evening onwards. He will be located near the hold area and will remain on base throughout the event. Phone number for Earl is 027 230 3674.

Rubbish

- Please take all rubbish home with you as bins will not be provided.

Prize Giving

- Prize giving will be held on each evening at the completion of the day's events.
- If you cannot attend prize giving then please arrange for any prizes you may have won to be collected by someone else. Prizes will not be available for collection prior to prize giving.

Prize Giving Meal

- This will be held at 6.30pm on Saturday evening. BYO drinks, chairs plates and cutlery (if required).
- Cost of prize giving meal is \$20, buffet burger and chips (three meat and vegetarian option).
- If you require a meal ticket then please order and pay for these with your Definite Entries.
- If you require prize giving meals and these have not been ordered via a competitor, email the secretary with your meal ticket request.
- Meal tickets will be required to get your meal. Meal tickets will be in with your back number. Or if not ordered by a competitor, then collect from the secretary.
- All meals need to be ordered by 22 January. Late orders cannot be accepted.

Ride Secretary

- The Ride Secretary will be located in the secretary's caravan.
- Log Books and Passports will be available to collect at Prize Giving. If you have to leave earlier then please arrange for someone to collect your logbook/passport or supply the ride secretary with a large stamped, addressed envelope so the logbook/passport/certificate/ribbon can be posted to you. These items will not be posted out otherwise.
- Back numbers can be collected from 9am Friday onwards regardless of which day you are riding. Please collect no later than midday on the day of pre-ride vetting for your class.

Best Conditioned Judging

- All horses eligible for BC must remain in the hold area until the commencement of BC judging unless advised otherwise by the Ground Jury or Chief Steward.
