Ride Base

- Ride base is about 5km from Renwick.
- Toilets and water provided but bring own yarding, camping gear, etc.
- Showers are available at the Renwick Sport and Event Centre, 8 Uxbridge Street Renwick. Cost is \$2 per shower and you can leave your payment in the box provided. See the whiteboard for the lockbox code to access the showers.
- All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on ride base.
- No arriving after dark please, respect those living in the homes on the property and nearby.
- There are two gates into the ride base paddock – the main driveway, which has a cattle stop, but is fairly narrow (ok for standard sized vehicles) and another gate, also off SH63, in the top corner. We recommend using the second gate for trucks and wider vehicles.
- A map will be drawn up shortly but there is plenty of room for everyone.

Entries

- Definite entries close at 5pm Friday 11 April. Definite entries are done through this [link](#)
- Refunds are at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Health and Safety

- For the purpose of our event, the venue opens at 12pm on Wednesday 23 April 2025.
- It will also be necessary for the rider to collect their rider back number before their horse can be ridden at the venue.
- At any time the person riding the horse must wear the rider back number allocated to the horse. If this is outside of your competition then turn your rider bib inside out.
- Please keep well clear of the start/finish area and the track leading to the start/finish while exercising horses.
- Safety helmets and appropriate footwear must be worn at all times while riding.
- ESNZ GR Article 151.7 - The use of cameras by riders while riding at a showground/competition venue (however such a camera is affixed, whether to the rider, protective headgear, head covering, or carriage) is prohibited, unless otherwise specifically agreed to by the ESNZ Technical Delegate officiating at the Event (in consultation with the President of the GJ, where appropriate). Such a decision will be completely at the discretion of the Technical Delegate/GJ President, and not subject to challenge. In the event that approval is given by the Technical Delegate/GJ President, an athlete's decision to wear a camera while competing will always be voluntary and at the athlete's own risk.

- The fire risk could still be very high so we advise you to limit smoking to your own vehicles please, and be prepared for a total fire/smoking ban in extreme high risk. No open fires.

FEI Competitors

- ALL competitors riding in FEI competitions need to comply with the FEI Veterinary Regulations in regards to having uploaded their horse's health certificate and temperatures in the 3 days leading up to the event, and while at the event. Manure

- All manure is to be scattered or taken home with you.

Training Area

- A separate training track will be provided. There is to be no riding anywhere else apart from this training track. Please note that this property is a working farm and vineyard and health and safety is paramount.

Stallions

- Please advise if you are bringing a stallion.

Ice

- At this stage no Ice will be available at the ride base but it can be purchased at Supermarkets and Service Stations at Renwick.

Water

- There is plenty of water available at the ride base for horses, drinking and strapping. It is recommended to bring human drinking water with you.

Hay

- Premium Meadow and Lucerne hay is available to purchase. Please order and pay for with your entry. It will be delivered to base by Wednesday 23 April.

Farrier

- Any request for farrier work will be at the rider's own expense. There will be farriers on base from Thursday.

Rubbish

- Please take all rubbish home with you as bins will not be provided.

Prize Giving

- Prize giving will be held on Sunday 27 April.
- If you cannot attend prize giving then please arrange for any prizes you may have won to be collected by someone else. Prizes will not be available for collection prior to prize giving.

Prize Giving Meal

- Prize Giving dinner will be Sunday 27 April from 6pm. \$35 for everyone.
- BYO drinks, plates, cutlery and chairs.
- If you wish to join us, then please order a meal ticket and pay for these with your Definite Entries.
- If you are not riding and a competitor is not ordering your meal ticket you can order meal tickets on Evo.
- Meal tickets will be required to get your meal. Meal tickets will be in with your rider pack.
- All meals need to be ordered by 20 April. Late orders cannot be accepted.

Ride Secretary

- The Ride Secretary will be located in the secretary's caravan.
- Log Books and Passports will be available to collect at Prize Giving. If you have to leave earlier then please arrange for someone to collect your logbook/passport or supply the ride secretary with a large stamped, addressed envelope so the logbook/passport/certificate/ribbon can be posted to you. These items will not be posted out otherwise.
- Back numbers can be collected from 12pm Thursday onwards regardless of which day you are riding. Please collect no later than midday on the day of pre-ride vetting for your class.

Best Conditioned Judging

All horses eligible for BC must remain in the hold area until the commencement of BC judging unless advised otherwise by the Ground Jury or Chief Steward.

Event payment

Class entry fees, clean sport testing fees (for CEI classes only), Casual memberships, flexi fees and prize giving dinner, are due with your definite entry. Event payments should be calculated from the table on the following page:
