Terms and Conditions

Entry Conditions

Online entries close Friday 13 October with evoevents.com

No postal or email entries will be accepted. Entries are only accepted once we have received all required documentation and they are paid in full. Late entries will be accepted up to 5pm 21 October and incur 50% retained.

Definitions

Late Entry Deemed to be a new competitor or horse *not already entered* by the closing date 13

October. Late entries will be accepted up to 5pm 21 October and incur 50% retained.

Class Change Those competitors already entered may alter their entered classes up to 5 pm the day prior.

These *must be made online* to be accepted. No emails or in-person changes will be accepted. Changed entries must ride first in drawn classes. Class changes incur 25%

retained.

A horse substitution may be made with the secretary *prior to* the class commencing. The

rider must still start in their drawn order.

Scratchings You no longer wish to, or are not able to, compete in a class and are withdrawing. All

scratchings should be completed *online* by 5 pm the day prior. In late or unexpected situations, your scratching *must still be notified* to the ring steward of your class.

Fees and Levies

Ground Levy - \$25 per horse/pony

Camping Levy - \$10 per truck/float per night

Medical/Admin Levy - \$40 per rider (non-refundable)

ESNZ Jumping Levy - \$7 per horse/pony

Stables/Covered yards - \$50 for the show. Only horses entered and competing will be allocated yards or stables. Preference will be given to those competing at higher levels.

Open yards - \$30 for the show. These must be pre-booked.

Preference will be given to non-local competitors. If yards are left dirty competitors will not have a yard allocated to them in the future and may be invoiced for costs. Yard allocation is final and will not be changed.

Refunds less 25% if notified to the event secretary by 7.00 pm three days prior to the show. Refunds after that less 50% at the committee's discretion.

Money owed - this show will use the ESNZ Jumping Policy on Debt Collection to follow up any unpaid accounts. This can be found on the ESNZ website.

Prize money - will be paid out by direct credit within 14 days after the show. *Include your bank details* with your entry.

Cancellation - In case of cancellation, the medical/admin fee will be, and a small percentage of entry fees may be retained to cover out of pocket expenses only.

General Conditions

- 1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
- 2. The committee reserves the right to alter the programme as required.
- 3. Ring 1 to be run in strict catalogue order. Ring 2 in draw order with preference given to competitors with Ring 1 commitments. Ring 3 to run with a blackboard.
- 4. Please ensure registrations and memberships are up to date. Failure to do so may result in loss of points, placings, prize money after the show and may result in a rider being fined under ESNZ Jumping conditions.
- 5. Horses (1.10m & under) & ponies (1m & under) can compete under the <u>casual levy system</u> as per ESNZ regulations.
- 6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Committee reserves the right to evict and eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable or unsafe manner.
- 7. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between the hours of 8pm and 6am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet.
- 8. Standard of dress is FORMAL. Tidy attire must be worn whilst walking courses.
- 9. Dogs are not encouraged. If you find it necessary to bring your dog, it MUST be on a lead or tied up at ALL times during events. It is lambing season on the grounds any dogs found off-lead or wandering will result in owners being immediately removed from the grounds with no refund.
- 10. Photographers on the grounds are by application and/or invitation only. Any photographer outside of this may be asked to leave.
- 11. Competitors enter at their own risk and the organisers take no responsibility for any injury to horses, riders or spectators or any damage to competitors or spectators property.
- 12. Food trucks will be on site for the duration of the event.

Show Hunter conditions

- 1. Show Hunter practice rounds must be entered online through EVO with your entries.
- 2. All Riders must have a current ESNZ Rider Membership to compete in ANY Show Hunter Classes
- 3. All Equines must have a Current ESNZ Equine Registration and an Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start to gain Horse of the Year Qualifying Points but can compete on a casual jumping levy WITHOUT earning points.
- 4. This is a Horse of the Year Qualifying Show for the 2023-2024 Season.
- 5. Ponies must compete in the correct category for ESNZ Hi Points classes, and must have a current height certificate to compete.

ECPH Double or Quits

- 1. There is no extra cost to competitors. When the competitor rides into the ring they tell the judge whether they are riding for "double" or "quits". The double only relates to 1st place.
- 2. The competitor with the fastest time and has nominated double would get double first place prize money. EG Class 3 Horse 1.20m A2 PM for 1st is \$120 so the winner could pocket \$240 if selected "double"
- 3. A competitor who nominates "double" and doesn't get the fastest time but is placed in the class would receive the ribbon for their placing, but no prize money.
- 4. Competitors who nominate "quits" and get placed would receive the scheduled ribbon & prize money.
