How it will run:

- Pick a level 65-80 or 95-1.05 so we can organize a draw.
- Show-jumping pick 10 out of the many jumps set-up. **Carry on straight into your Cross-Country derby course.** 65-105 jumps will be flagged, you pick your height.
- The course will finish just after the main water -jump, approx. 12 cross country fences. No timing will be done. Purely for fun.
- Dressage: 1ring available with a judge, nominate your test and you can discuss with the judge afterwards. (limited numbers)
- We will allocate approx. times, to make the day short for everyone.
- No refunds, in order to keep cost to a minimum and workload low.
- No entries on the day.
- Event will run rain, hail, sunshine 😊

Guidelines:

- Vet will be on call. Ambulance will be onsite.
- We will start with the first level 65-80, then will alter the show-jumping ring up to 95-1.05 If time and daylight allows we may be able to raise the show-jumping again at the end of the day.
- Please advise which dressage test you wish to do in the general comments.
- Rules pertaining to “abuse of horse” and “dangerous riding apply” You will be asked to leave the grounds.
- No dogs allowed.
- Only flagged jumps are available to be jumped.
- 2 stops in either show jumping or cross country, move to next jump please.

- You can do a second round.
- Rider's under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Rider's dress and saddlery must meet the requirements of "ESNZ Rules of Eventing"
In particular they must wear an approved tagged helmet, appropriate footwear and a body protector that meets the standards as at 1 August 2020 for all jumping.
- All riders to sign an acknowledgement of risk/waiver of responsibility and code of conduct form.
- No ESNZ membership requirements apply to practice days.

Please come and have some fun or do a warm-up test and showjumping round for Puhinui, and help us to raise money to purchase some new show-jumps for Ring 2.
