CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:

The criteria for winning the One Day Event Trophies is based on the HORSE only as per Art 674 and not on the combination of horse and rider.

Article 674 - NEW ZEALAND SHORT FORMAT CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1. Forest Gate Trophy Awarded to the winner of the championship class run under 4* conditions.
- 2. Waiteko Trophy Awarded to the highest placed **eligible Horse** of the championship class run under 3* conditions.
- 3. Ferndale Trophy Awarded to the highest placed **eligible Horse** of the championship class run under 2* conditions.
- 4. Tait Trophy Awarded to the highest placed **eligible Horse** of the championship class run under 1* conditions.
- **In 2, 3 and 4 above**, the respective New Zealand Short Format Championship title will be awarded to the highest placed combination where **the Horse** has achieved no more than two MER's at a level higher than that for which the New Zealand Championship title is being awarded.

- No Dogs allowed on property.
- A waitlist will be kept for CCN80 and CCN95 classes up till Monday 18th March.
- No stallions, we do not have facilities to cater for them.
- YARDS on the grounds are limited.
- Farrier will be on the grounds.
- All Waikato riders will be allocated a Cross Country class to jump judge.
- By making an entry riders are liable for all fees, even if they do not attend the event. If you subsequently scratch, the refund policy will apply, Article 646. Please note no refund on Admin and late entry fees.
- Protests to be lodged at the office on the correct form with appropriate fee.
- Late payments entry will incur a late fee \$30/horse if money is not in the bank by 12 noon Friday
 15th March.
- Prize Money: Paid out at ratio 1:5 starters for national classes and 1:4 for CCI classes. Committee
 reserves the right to substitute prize money with sponsors goods to the value of, at their
 discretion.
- Prize money may be adjusted if classes are split. RWT will be deducted from prizemoney over \$500.
- Official Photographers only.
- Please bring cash for coffee/food limited EFTPOS available.
- Showers/Toilets available in the AZTECH shed.
- Prize giving will be announced, All place getters from 1st to 5th to be mounted. You must attend prize giving to collect rosettes, no proxies allowed.

- CCN 95 Rider full or Introductory membership. Horse can be casual.
- CCN80 Rider full, Introductory or Casual. Horse can be casual.

IMPORTANT - ALL COMPETITORS IN FEI CLASSES

In accordance with the FEI Veterinary Regulations 2022 the Horse Health Requirements are being rolled out globally as of 1 January 2022. Derived from the EHV-1 By-Laws, applied in Mainland Europe from 31 May to 31 December 2021, the Horse Health Requirements have been put in place to:

- protect FEI Horses and global equestrian sports from the consequences of infectious diseases being transmitted before, during and after FEI Events
- provide reassurance of the high health of equestrian sport Horses to global, continental and national veterinary authorities and organisations
- maintain and further improve the conditions for international movement of sport Horses

There are new requirements from the FEI which require riders/grooms to record horses temperatures twice daily for the three days prior to arrival at the competition venue. Temperatures are also required to be taken twice daily while at the venue.

These temperatures will be loaded into the FEI HorseApp which you will need to download. See the link below and make yourself familiar with the requirements.

Please note that this is an FEI requirement and is done through the app directly with the FEI. Failure to comply will result at best a warning from the FEI and or sanctions on the horse involved.

So please take this seriously and have your horses registered well before the event and showing on the FEI HorseApp otherwise you will not be able to compete.
