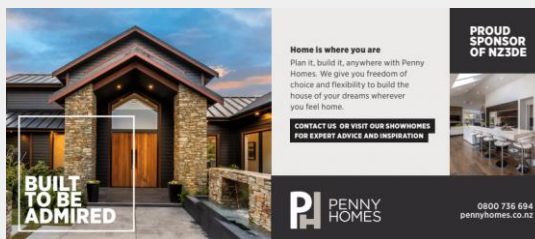

NZ WARBLOOD ASSOCIATION YOUNG EVENT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

1. Horse to be four or five years old at date of final based on foaling date 1 August.
2. Rider to be 15 years old or over.
3. Horse to be 15hh or over and ridden in a snaffle bridle.
4. Depending on timetabling a limit of 20 horses may be required. Minimum of 5 x 4 year olds will be accepted.
5. In the event entries need to be limited the following conditions will apply, horses will be balloted based on the highest performance record from 1st August 2023
 - a. 4 year olds performance at a CCN80 or ESNZ express events
 - b. 5 year olds performance at a ESNZ Eventing CCN95 or ESNZ express events
 - c. All remaining unqualified horses will be waitlisted and accepted if space allows
6. Excessive entries not accepted into the YEH class entry fees will be refunded entry fee, excluding the online entry fee.
7. Format of the Competition:
 - a. Each of the 4 tests has an individual judge.
 - b. The judges look for an athletic, loose moving horse with a promising jumping technique which, with correct training, should make a good event horse. Martingales and boots are optional but only minimal time allowed for change of gear will be allowed for change of tack between sections.
 - i. Simple dressage test. Emphasis on paces and trainability, No boots are martingales.
 - ii. Jumping. Approx 10-12 fences, mix of Show jumps & Cross-Country fences, Show jumps not to exceed 1 metre and cross country jumps not to exceed 95cm.
PLEASE NOTE THAT SINCE THERE ARE CROSS COUNTRY JUMPS INVOLVED IN THIS CLASS A BACK PROTECTOR MUST BE WORN.
 - iii. Gallop to be suitable for XC, and
 - iv. Movement, Conformation and Suitability of Type.
8. At the end of this judging the top 5 horses on points will compete in front of all the judges who will decide the final placings. Points will not carry through, although in the event of a tie, points from the qualifying round will decide the winner. Horses will be asked to complete up to a 2-minute freestyle dressage display followed by 5-6 jumps.
9. Dressage test to be found at the back of the schedule. Thank you for your entry into the Young Event Horse Class.

In a move to increase the integrity of this competition and to align with ESNZ Eventing rules we recommend all horses have breed papers or a passport to prove not only the pedigree, but also the year of birth of your horse and have this recorded at ESNZ .

If you are competing a thoroughbred, simply send in a printout from Studbook | Stud Book (loveracing.nz)

If you are competing on a warmblood horse and do not have papers please contact either the NZWA or the NZ Hanoverian Society get papers for this horse.

If you are competing a crossbred you can contact www.sphanz.co.nz to gain a passport that way, and if your horse is a specific non-warmblood breed (eg Irish Sport Horse) please contact the relevant breed organisation.

We are sure you will agree that ensuring all the pedigree information on each horse is correct and the breeder of your horse is recognised is an important step forward in promoting these young event horse classes.

1. **All riders are encouraged at the time of entry to provide the Name and Cell Phone Detail of a Cross Country Fence Judge**, we will ensure they are allocated to a course that is not yours to ensure they can enjoy your ride, we thank you in advance for your cooperation - as you know we cannot run without support in this particular area.
2. Refer to Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MER) in FEI Rules and Regulations and ESNZ Eventing Rules for details of qualification criteria. It is the rider 's responsibility to ensure MERs are met at time of entry. All entries will be checked that MERs have been met from the online database. Any entries that have not met the required MER will **not** be accepted until MERs have been met as per MER deadlines. These have been detailed in each class schedule above.
3. Silver Spurs Trophy - Inter-Island teams' competition.
4. Caseley Trophy - best presented horse over the entire competition – judged by a mystery judge.
5. Charlton Stud Prize - best performed mare over the entire competition.
6. NZPCA Award. Rosette and rug to the highest placed Pony Club rider at the event. Pony Club riders must nominate and complete their PC information in their Evo Events account to be eligible for this award. The winner will be calculated under the Swarbrick Scale. The NZPCA Rally Rule applies.
7. ESNZ Eventing Chair and Vice Chair Awards for CCN105 and below:
"Best Performed First-Time Competitor at the NZ3DE, Taupo"

8. The Rider Shop/Rangiora Equestrian Cross Country Style Prize will be chosen from combinations competing in classes 5 - 8. The winner receives a \$50 voucher.

10. The Organising Committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Eventing Rules Articles 610 & 611.
11. Article 610 – DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Neither the Organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to Horses, owners, Athletes, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
12. Classes will be run under all applicable FEI Rules and Regulations and where applicable the 2023 ESNZ Eventing Rules. ALL riders should consult the rules for information regarding qualifications, including Minimum Eligibility Requirements, qualifying periods and deadlines. If entering Class 4 CCN1*L please ensure you know the difference the in rules between a CCN105 and a CCN1*.
13. Excessive entries and balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Eventing Article 645.
14. All horses in classes 1-4 are required to have either a FEI Passport/Recognition Card or fully completed Official ESNZ Identification Papers (either ID Book or ID Page).
15. ARRIVAL INSPECTION; ALL HORSES from classes 1 to 4 and any horses from classes 5 to 9 who travel with or are stabled with horses competing in classes 1 to 4 need to be presented to the Arrival Inspection and will be subject to all relevant stable rules and announcements. Arrival Inspections will take place on Wednesday afternoon & Thursday Morning, details will be shared in the Rider Notes.
16. All horses entered in classes 1 - 4 are required to be accommodated on the grounds for the duration of the event.
17. Leased yard holders will be charged for facility fees at time of entry.
18. Entries online at EvoEvents and payments made through Poli, please include the rider name. By entering online, you are making an agreement with the Organising Committee and all fees are due even if you do not start at the event. Entries not fully paid at time of entry will be held until full payment is received.
19. Late entries will be subject to a late entry fee of \$50. Late payments will be subject to a late payment fee of \$20 if funds are not received within two working days after close of entries.
20. All scratchings are to be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646.

REFUNDS:

21. Requests for refunds will not be accepted after 28 May 2023. Vet certificate are required.
22. Riders in FEI classes, CCI, scratching from the event 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 7th May 2024) will be entitled to a 50% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.
23. Riders in national classes, CCN, scratching from the event 48 hours before the start of competition (before 8.00am Tuesday 7th May 2023) will be entitled to an 80% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.
24. All fees for combinations who do not gain the required qualification will be refunded in full, less a \$15 Admin Fee, and the Evo Event fee by the 31st May 2024.
25. Double Entries \$10, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 644.
26. All entries will be charged a non-refundable Administration Fee of \$15 per horse.
27. All fees and prize monies listed in this schedule include GST.
28. Accommodation to be completed online with your entry.
29. Presentation of Prizes & Prize Money:

Unless otherwise notified in writing with entry, prize money will be paid in full (subject to IRD deductions), to the rider by Direct Credit to the bank account nominated on MY ACCOUNT in Evo Events by 20th June-2024 (subject to the results of any clean sport testing).

The Organising Committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with product of equal or greater value – article 611

Individual prizes more than \$500 will have withholding tax deducted at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is completed prior to receiving the prize money, otherwise at the relevant no declaration rate of 45%. Individual circumstances do vary. Evo Events will work with you to ensure the tax is appropriate for your circumstance, rules vary for Limited Liability, Partnerships and Trusts. See ESNZ Eventing Articles 619 & 620.
