Ride Base

- Ride base is at the Āpiti Domain, 601 Oroua Valley Road, Āpiti
- **No dogs**
- All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on ride base

Directions to Venue

Travelling from the South:

- Go to Feilding and head north-east on Kimbolton Road (SH54)
- Pass through Cheltenham (do not turn left at the dairy), continue through Kiwitea and Kimbolton
 - Kimbolton Road becomes Rangiwahia Road
- Approx 2 km after Kimbolton, turn right onto Āpiti Road (signs for Sixtus Lodge), follow for approximately 12km Āpiti Domain is on your left-hand side (1km before the village)

Travelling from the North – Route One – not suitable for trucks due to weight limits (6,000 kg) on the old bridge

- Follow SH1 south towards Mangaweka
- Just after the long downhill before Mangaweka, turn left onto Manawatū Scenic Route (Ruahine Road - signs for Rangiwahia)
 - A little before the Rangiwahia village turn left on Te Parapara Road (Manawatu scenic route, signposted for Āpiti); Te Parapara Road becomes Oroua Valley Road
- Pass through Āpiti village
- Āpiti Domain is on your right-hand side, (approximately 1km past the village)

Travelling from the North – Route Two (bypassing the old Mangaweka Bridge)

- After Utiku (The Wool Shop) take the next left onto Toe Toe Road.
- Make a hard right turn onto Potaka Road and this takes you down over the Kawhatau River.
- Turn right onto Kawhatau Valley Road and this brings you back towards Mangaweka
- Turn left onto Manawatū Scenic Route and follow directions as above (towards Rangiwahia)

Definite Entries

- Definite entries close at 8pm, Wednesday 30th March and all fees must be paid by this date.
- Entries will not be taken at the event.

Health and Safety

- Please keep well clear of the start/finish area and the track leading to the start/finish while exercising horses.

- Safety helmets (must conform with one of the current approved safety standards and bears the ESNZ/NZPCA helmet tag) must be worn at all times while riding.
- Appropriate footwear: safe riding footwear with a heel of 12 mm or more, or alternatively caged/ covered stirrups or equestrian safety stirrups are compulsory for all riders.
- Competitors Attire: as this is a Championship event, Jodhpurs, breeches or riding tights and a shirt with a collar must be worn when riding and tidy clothing is also required within the Field of Play (strapping & hold area and Vet Ring).
- ESNZ GR Article 150.6 It is the responsibility of every individual at an equestrian event to ensure the health and safety of themselves and others.
- ESNZ GR Article 151.7 - The use of cameras by riders while riding at a showground/competition venue (however such a camera is affixed, whether to the rider, protective headgear, head covering, or carriage) is prohibited, unless otherwise specifically agreed to by the Technical Delegate.

Yarding

- Yards must comply with ESNZ Endurance Rule 2.19 yarding requirements see ESNZ rules [HERE](#)
- Yards are required for horses staying overnight.
- Horses competing on the day can be tied to a truck or float but must be supervised by an adult at all times when tied up.
- It is mandatory for all horses to have halters on while they are in their yards. All horses MUST be able to be identified at all times with the person responsible and phone number e.g. tag or tape affixed to halter, bridle or saddle.

Manure & hay

- All yards must be mucked out prior to your departure, please kick and spread manure around base.
- Waste hay must be placed around the fence lines (in the waste areas).

Training Area

- A designated track for exercising horses will be available from 10 am Wednesday 13th April

Stallions

- Please advise if you are bringing a stallion.

Prize Giving Meal

- Meal tickets will be required to get your meal. Meal tickets will be in with your back number. Or if not ordered by a competitor, then collect from Jo.
- All meals need to be ordered by 30 March. Late orders cannot be accepted.

Prize Giving

- Prize giving will be held on Sunday evening in the Pavilion.
- If you cannot attend prize giving then please arrange for any prizes you may have won to be collected by someone else. Prizes will not be available for collection prior to prize giving.

Ice

- Ice will not be available at the ride base but it can be purchased at Supermarkets and Service Stations in the Feilding area.
- We're trying to get a freezer at ride base for storage of people's ice supplies but this is not yet confirmed

Fuel

- Fuel is available in Kimbolton, Feilding or Taihape.

Water

- There is plenty of water available at the ride base for both horses and humans.

Farrier

- Any request for farrier work will be at the rider's own expense. Bert Jordan will be on base from very early Friday morning. He will be located near the hold area and will remain on base throughout the event. Phone number for Bert is 021 713 919.

Rubbish

- There will be blue Manawatu District Council rubbish bags available to purchase (\$3 each) or take your rubbish home with you.
- Please do not leave your empty bottles and other rubbish by your float / truck.
- Wool fadges will be available for recycling glass and cans
- It is not the job of the OC to clean up after riders and their crew.

Horse Feed & Hay

- Hay will be available at \$12/bale, contact Murray or Andrea Smith smithenduranceteam@outlook.com in advance to arrange. Farmlands, PGG Wrightson and Farm Source have stores in Feilding or Taihape. If you require horse feed, please organise this directly with the store.

Ride Secretary

- The Ride Secretary will be located in the Pavilion.
- Logbooks and Passports will be available to collect at Prizegiving. If you have to leave earlier then please arrange for someone to collect your logbook/passport or supply the ride secretary with a large stamped, addressed envelope so the logbook/passport/certificate/ribbon can be posted to you. These items will not be posted out otherwise.
- Back numbers can be collected from 9am Thursday regardless of which day you are riding. Please collect no later than midday on the day of pre-ride vetting for your class.

Best Conditioned Judging

- The time for BC Judging will be announced each day once it is known which horses will be eligible.
- All horses eligible for BC must remain in the hold area until the commencement of BC judging unless advised otherwise by the Ground Jury or Chief Steward.

Conditions of Entry

- Entries and fees must be received by 8pm on 30th March 2022 for entries to be valid.
- A full refund of entry fee will be available for an entry withdrawn by 10am on the day of pre-ride vetting for the class in which entered.
- It is the responsibility of the rider / owner of the horse to notify the ride secretary in writing of any change to the entry. Any change to entries must be done by 9am on the day of pre-ride vetting for the class in which entered.

- Each competitor must supervise and control his / her horse(s) at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
