



Eventing – TiES New Zealand Bloodstock Newcomer Award



2022/2023 Competition Outline

Eligible Classes

All classes run under ESNZ Eventing Rules, CCN/CCI format, from 20 August 2022 until 30 April 2023, are eligible for TiES NZB Newcomer Award points.

Points Allocation **

Points will be allocated according to a thoroughbred's placing and performance in each series class as per the table below:

**Points will only be awarded if there is a minimum of two starters.

In the event of a tie then the placings shall be decided by a count back of the highest placings of the rounds that incurred points for the season.

TiES Registered Horses will be not be placed independently, this is to reflect the thoroughbred's performance as well as participation.

Series Period

The TiES Competition starts from 20 August 2022 and ends with Rotorua Horse Trials 30 April 2023 being the last event for the series.
