



Jumping – TiES New Zealand Bloodstock Newcomer Award



2022/2023 Competition Outline

Eligible Classes

Only Jumping National Series Classes will be eligible for TiES NZB Newcomer Award points. The horse can be ridden by different rider as the horse will earn points as opposed to a combination.

Points Allocation

Points will be allocated as per the ESNZ Jumping Series Rules.

The points that the thoroughbred gains in the series classes will be the points allocated for TiES NZB Newcomer Award. Individual horses may gain points in more than one series class.

TiES Registered Horses will be not be placed independently, this is to reflect the thoroughbred's performance as well as participation.

In the event of a tie then the placings shall be decided by a count back of the highest placings of the rounds that incurred points for the season.

Series Period

The Competition starts from the first Jumping Show of the season offering series classes and ends on **2 April 26 February 2023**, points allocation will stop after this date. **Please note that only postponed shows after 26 February 2023 will be allocating points – see note on page 2.**
