Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5: Riders need to be full ESNZ members.

Classes 1, 2 & 3 Horses and Riders must have current 2023 FEI Registration.

Class 4: Horse must be registered with ESNZ and have the correct eventing annual start.

Class 5: Horses not registered with ESNZ may enter under ESNZ Casual Equine Registration, \$5 plus \$15 Flexi start.

Classes 6 & 7: Riders need to be full ESNZ members or an introductory ESNZ member.

Classes 6 & 7: Horses may enter under Casual Equine Fee \$5 if the horse is not registered with ESNZ.

a) Entries must be in the hands of the secretary by 5pm Monday 10th April 2023

b) **Entry fees MUST be paid by close of entries date. Riders will not be put in the draw if entry fees are unpaid.**

e) **Every Northland competitor is required to supply a XC jump judge. Please provide name & contact phone number.**

f) All classes are open to horses and ponies as per the rules of ENZ.

g) Young Rider age rules apply to class 7 as per ENZ rules. Young rider = until end of calendar year they turn 21 (i.e. Born 2002 or after).

h) Prize money for classes 1 – 3 will be paid out at ratio 1:4 starters. RWT will be deducted from prizemoney over \$500.

i) Prize money for classes 4 – 7 will be paid out at ratio 1:5 starters Prize money may be substituted with sponsor's prizes to the value of or part thereof

j) **Dogs must be on leads at all times.**

k) **Late entries, if accepted, will incur a \$10 late fee & will NOT be refundable.** Refunds must be applied for in writing & received by the Event Secretary within 7 days of competition. For 80% refund, scratching must be received by 8.00am Thursday 20th April 2023.

l) The organising committee reserves the right to alter the program as required. **Article 611 -Reservation of Right.**

m) The Eventing NZ XC Style prize will be awarded – sponsored by The Rider Shop – winner to receive a \$50 voucher.

n) This event is run under ESNZ General Regulations and ESNZ Eventing Rules and is part of ESNZ Eventing National Series. Classes 1 -3 are run under FEI Rules. Classes 4 – 7 are run under Eventing NZ Rules.

o) Northland riders must bring a plate of food for the Officials catering for both days.

**Administration and Medic Fee: \$30 per rider. Non-refundable.**

**Camping: Camping on the grounds \$10/rider.**

**Yards: \$40 per horse for the weekend.** The yards are sometimes overbooked. Onsite yarding will be allocated on a **first entered/first paid** basis. Overflow yarding will be at the Maungatapere Rodeo grounds on Kokopu Block Road which is approx. 5-10 minutes away from Barge. Non-competing horses will not be allocated yards on the Barge grounds.

**Approximate Timetable:** Friday: XC course open for walking at 5pm.

Saturday: Dressage/ Showjumping.

Sunday: Cross Country

**Prize giving:** Prizegiving will be held at the end of the event 30 minutes after FINAL results have been posted. Winners of each class to come correctly attired & mounted to have photo taken with cover and sponsor. Placegetters to be unmounted and correctly attired.
