## General Event Conditions & Information

- **Dogs-** must be on a leash (no longer than 5m) at all times & to be under control of suitable person. Failure to comply will result in fine for owner & or dog being removed from the grounds. All proceeds to NEC. Minimum fine per offence \$50.
- **Non-competition Horses** – not available for this event.
- **Restricted Classes** – Only eligible to horses who have not received an MER at the level above. EG. CCN95 Restricted – HORSE cannot have competed at CCN105 & received an MER this Inc NZPCA events– see Appendices in Eventing Rules for MER Rules.
- **Waitlist** will be in operation should classes be oversubscribed.
- This event is run under ESNZ eventing &/or FEI rules – effective 1 August 2022 and ESNZ General Regs – including membership & registration requirements.
- **ESNZ/ESNZ Eventing Registration** – All athletes must be ESNZ Members to compete, casual membership is available for CCN80-S. Horse registration and discipline annual start required for CCN1\*-S and above, casual equine registration is available for CCN105-S and below. Please contact ESNZ office for new memberships or registrations.
- **Rider's meeting** – CCI Riders meeting Friday Evening – after 6pm (time to be confirmed after final timetabling completed)
- **CCI** classes run under FEI rules. **CCN-S** classes run under ESNZ eventing rules.
- All competitors in classes 1, 2 & 3 are required to have either CCI passports (Class 1 must have CCI passport) or Official ESNZ identification papers - FEI Article 137.
- **Young & Junior Rider** – As per Articles 614.1.4; 614.1.5 & 675 or ESNZ Rules of Eventing & Article 503.2 of FEI Rules of Eventing, Junior Rider is to be aged 14 to 18 years; Young Rider 16 to 21 years of calendar year of birthday.
- **Camping/Yarding for Event:** Facility Use Fee – \$32 per horse; Camping \$30 per truck; Camping with Power \$50 per connection (Limited); Stable \$60 per horse (Limited); Covered Yard \$52 (Limited); Paddock \$32 per horse (Minimum 2 horses per paddock); Open Yard \$24. If you are arriving prior to Friday – you will need to pay extra facility, camping & yarding fees. Please notify Event Secretary. Competitors in CCI classes will have an extra day added to these charges.
- **Other Fees:** Admin Fee \$10 per Rider (non-refundable) Vet & Medic Fee \$20 per Rider
- **Late payments** – will incur the **Late Fee of \$25 per horse** if money is not in the bank account two working days after entries close.
- **Late Entries** – will incur the **Late Fee of \$25 per horse**.
- **Prizegiving/Prizes** – can be collected @ Official Prizegiving – those required will be notified. **Prizes will not be posted out – some classes have sponsored product that will require collecting.** Winners to be mounted, placegetters in riding attire, unmounted. Will be done at completion of CCI classes, results approval as per rules. Venue & Time to be advised. Prizes paid out on ratio 1:5
- **Refunds** – ALL classes 80% of entry fee up to 48 hours before event commences & all yarding & Testing fee refunded, where notified before start of competition (all scratchings must be posted through Evo Events). Refunds will be paid electronically into your bank account 20<sup>th</sup> month following. Other refunds at OC discretion. Event starts 8am Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022.
- **Refreshments** – available on the grounds. 😊
- **Tentative Timetable** – CCI classes will run Fri-Sun Drsg; XC; SJ – inc Arrival Inspection & 2 Veterinary Inspections – Friday morning & Sunday Morning. National classes will run Sat-Sun with Drsg & SJ Sat & XC Sun. Vet will be at finish for CCI classes, all CCI horses must go via vet (finish) on way back to truck after XC. OC retains right to change this as required.
- **XC Open for Walking** – no later than 24 hours prior to commencement of XC – after Official Course Walk & any necessary changes completed.

- All Horses attending must be allocated & use a yard – including horses competing that are not staying. **NO HORSES ARE TO BE TIED TO TRUCKS/FLOATS** unless tacking & untacking. This is a request from NEC, please respect this. You may be fined (\$50 per offence) for non-compliance.
- Riders must use their XC back number when schooling. Armband or bridle number in dressage & show jumping (or XC back number). All horses must always have an ID (either a personal ID or their competition number) on them whether being ridden or in the yards as per Article 651. It is preferable that those competing in National Classes (CCN) wear their XC #'s in all phases.
- The organising committee reserve the right to restrict entries as necessary, alter classes & prizes as required. Please Note that some Prize Money may be swapped for sponsored product or vouchers – Article 611

- **All local riders are encouraged to volunteer in some way – Please offer some help in any capacity.** We need your help to run this event 😊

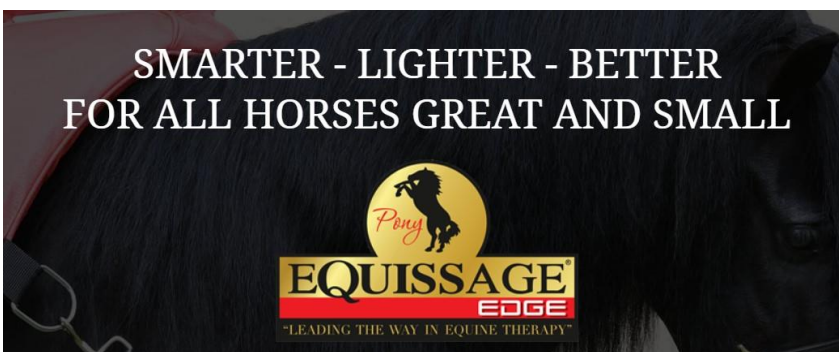
