

## **ESNZ Disciplinary review – process for submissions**

The ESNZ Disciplinary system (Chapter 9 of the ESNZ General Regulations) has been under review for many years and in 2018 we spent a great deal of time discussing this, how it could work better and what changes needed to be made to ensure consistency, fairness and equity and a clearer more responsive system for all of our members.

The attached DRAFT changes are now public for anyone to make a comment on and send in to us, there are some significant changes proposed in how we deal with complaints in general. These proposals are outlined in the document called “Summary of changes”. (To see the current General Regulations please see the link below)

All of the proposed are open for comment, please tell us if you think it is not right, if you would like some other issues considered, if you want to make any suggestions or have ideas that are not represented in these documents.

From here, the discipline boards will provide feedback by the end of February and then the ESNZ Technical Committee will review the changes in March. These can then be ratified by the ESNZ board and will come into play for the 2019-20 season. This should give disciplines enough time to make any changes to their discipline rules they might need to tidy up.
